LOGAN COUNTY'S LOCAL COST SHARE PROGRAMS

Cover Crop

- \$20 an Acre for a Maximum for \$1,000 pre operation per year (50 acres max)
- A minimum of 50 lbs/acre of cereal rye or 75 lbs/acre of wheat or barley will be used for this practice.
- Cover crops must be seeded by November 1, if not, then cost share will be rescinded.
- Cover crops cannot be harvested for hay, grain, or silage
- Other Districts with Cover Crop: Warren and Henry County



Pasture Program

Frost Proof Tank and Pipeline

- \$500 for Frost Proof Tank
- \$1.50 per foot of pipeline (1inch PVC)
- For livestock watering facilities; rock and filter fabric must also be installed around tank to prevent erosion by heavy traffic.
- Other Districts with Water Tank Programs: Franklin, Boyle, Knox and Laurel County



Fence Stream/Sinkhole

• **\$.50** a foot

- Must be fencing out streams or sinkholes
- Fencing must be minimum 4 strand barbwire or 4 strand (2 hot) electric high-tensile.
- Other Districts with Fence Cost Share: Knox and Knott County



No-Till & Strip-Till Vegetable or Tobacco Crop


No-Till Rate - \$200.00 per acre / \$1,000 maximum limit
Strip-Till Rate - \$150.00 per acre / \$1,000 maximum limit

No fill/ Strip fill Tobacco

Wildlife Food Plots

\$50 per acre up to \$250 Maximum

• Seedings can include annual grain crops or clover/legume plots.



Erosion Control Blankets

- 50% match on erosion control blankets up to \$1,000 per year
- Erosion Control Blankets must be used on areas seeded in permanent grass cover.
- Must follow NRCS seeding rates and planting dates


