
OPERATIONS

East Dundee Fire District (EDFD) responded to **379** incidents for the First Quarter of 2022 (January 1 through March 31), with a total of **581** apparatus responses, spending **335** hours and **14** minutes of time.

The ratio of EMS incidents to Fire incidents was 61% to 39%, respectively. Total Fire related calls for the quarter were 149. EMS related calls for the month were 230, including a total of 205 patients treated, with 118 of those transported to area hospitals. COVID-19 was suspected or confirmed in 37 patients.

Overlapping calls (at least one other call at the same time) represents approximately 26% (98 incidents) of the total call volume (379 incidents). 20 of the 122 incidents (16%) that happened during the hours of 8 PM to 8 AM represents overlapping calls.


For the months of January through March, EDFD averaged 1.66 Fire calls per day and 2.56 EMS calls per day for an overall daily average of 4.21 calls per day which is an increase of 26% over the same period of last year.




FIRE AND EMS CALL BREAKDOWN FOR APRIL 2022


