TERMS OF ENROLLMENT

TUITION INCLUDING RESIDENCE IN OTERO WELCOME HOME

CHARGES ARE FOR TUITION IN THE OTERO WELCOME HOME PROGRAM (NOT RENT) RESIDENCY IS INCIDENTAL, NOT MANDATORY **All charges are payable in advance, non-refundable, and are subject to change without notice.**

"TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE!"

Payment in advance of \$250.00 to reserve a bed for up to 10 days, after which \$100.00 tuition must be paid each Friday at 7:30 PM so long as any portion of the Otero Welcome Home residence is occupied or reserved by, or a resident remains in, the program. **All tuition must be paid prior to use of any services provided by Otero Welcome Home.**

The tuition is non-refundable and will be retained by Otero Welcome Home regardless of the reason for failure to occupy one of its residences.

Accommodations to be supplied by Otero Welcome Home in exchange for each tuition payment of \$120.00 include the use for one week (seven calendar days) of a bed (upper or lower bunk to be assigned by the Otero Welcome Home Coordinator) use of the bathroom (schedule to be arbitrated by the Coordinator) use of the kitchen in cooperation with the other residents as coordinated by the Coordinator and use of the common room, television and grounds as arbitrated by the Coordinator.

I hereby certify that I have carefully read and am in full agreement with the items I have checked below.

Full Curriculum requires 1 year. Initial enrollment is for 60 days for non Offenders. 90 day minimum for Offenders or more if required by a Judge or be Probation official.

, after which enrollee may discuss a longer stay with the coordinator. Violation of any of the following terms of agreement may result in automatic immediate eviction and notification to Probation Officer from the Otero Welcome Home Residence; however, he will not be excluded from the fellowship, meetings and lecture programs which are so vital to full recovery.

Residents are invited to attend Fellowship Meetings, Bible Studies and Seminars sponsored by Otero Welcome Home, said events to be announced and to be held from time to time in the Otero Welcome Home Resource. Monday thru *Friday night Bible Classes, Sunday Church and then a Church of your choice and certain other meetings to be announced is mandatory unless Job forbids or 30 day not to leave premises.*

GENERAL RULES and RESTRICTIONS

- 1. That smoking on the premises of any Otero Welcome Home facility **at the Gazebo**. Please note that a bench and butt can has been provided in the designated outdoor smoking area. **Use of the butt can is mandatory.**
- 2. To use the butt can, and not to deface or damage buildings, signs, equipment, etc.
- 3. Not to drink any intoxicating beverage or consume any illegal substance.
- 4. Not to possess any illegal substance in, about or on my person; or, if it becomes known that I have indulged in the use or distribution of any illegal substance after becoming a resident of a Otero Welcome Home facility, I will voluntarily vacate my residency. The Probation officer will be immediately notified.
- 5. Not to entertain a prostitute (male or female), indulge erotic, pornographic or adult entertainment. All are considered by Otero Welcome Home to be forms of obsessive addiction and are expressly forbidden.
- 6. Not to lie, cheat, steal, spread rumors, argue, curse, and/or indulge in other undesirable activity.
- 7. I understand that guests of the opposite sex are PROHIBITED from being inside the dorm or within fenced areas of the campus at all times. Guests may be entertained in the designated social room from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM unless the facility is booked for another activity.
- 8. Residents of any Otero Welcome Home facility agree to attend the "Bible Studies" which meets Monday thru Friday evenings at 6:30 PM. They should bring their Bibles and come expecting to, *without fear of criticism*, share their view points on the announced topic. Exceptions will be granted to those having conflicting work schedules.
- 9. Residents of any Otero Welcome Home facility agree to attend The Gathering Place service from 9:00 AM until 10:30 AM each Sunday. After 10:00 AM each person will be free to attend the church of their choice if they desire. Exceptions will be granted to those having conflicting work schedules.
- 10. Residents of any Otero Welcome Home facility agree to, under the supervision of the Otero Welcome Home Coordinator, maintain the interior and exterior of the Otero Welcome Home buildings in a clean, neat and orderly condition at all times; and, to keep the surrounding grounds free from all garbage, trash, weeds or other unsightly matter. They further agree to keep the landscape rock neatly and safely spread with no underlying mat showing; and, to keep all plants trimmed, watered and fertilized.
- 11. Residents agree to refrain from bringing any item having an offensive odor into any Otero Welcome Home facility. Such items include food, drink, dirty clothing, perfumes, shaving lotions, soaps, candles, shoes, etc. In the event any resident complains, the Otero Welcome Home Coordinator will remove the offending article at the owner's expense.
- 12. Residents agree to share the clothes hanging space in their room without dispute.
- 13. Except for the bathroom door(s) when using, residents agree to keep all interior doors unlocked at all times, thus making access by all residents to the bathroom possible both day & night. Residents further agree to unlock bathroom door(s) and to turn off the light(s) and fan each time they vacate the bathroom. All **privacy locks must be the same brand installed throughout the Otero Welcome Home facility so that it can be keyed to accommodate the Otero Welcome Home Master Key. The fire code requires this. Violation of this will result in immediate eviction..** **Residents agree to allow search (without warrant) by the Otero Welcome Home Coordinator and/or public authorities) of their rooms & belongings at all times & without notice.**
- 14. Unless clearly marked as to who purchased them, all food, drink, confection items, toiletries and soaps brought into any Otero Welcome Home Residence are to be shared by the residents. Arguments over unmarked items will not be tolerated.

15. Each person will be required to share in the cleanup after meals. Meals are considered to be a time of sharing; a time to pray with and for one another; a time to bear one another's burdens openly, without the intimidation of the administrative staff of Otero Welcome Home. Each person is obligated to supply a portion of the food used to prepare any common meal.

16. Prescription medications must be kept in a place secure from other residents. Each resident is responsible for such items belonging to him/her. **ABUSE OF MEDICATIONS WILL NOT TOLERATED!**

FREEDOM HOUSE COVENANT

Under the ministry of Donald L. Hoffman, Otero Welcome Home is dedicated to COMPLETE recovery of addicts and alcoholics; and, to the successful re-entry of previously incarcerated individuals into mainstream society. Since most recovery programs involve a person with a "God of their understanding" and in a philosophy that confesses, "Once an addict always an addict", many of those undergoing recovery are truly seeking a program that promises ultimate **complete recovery through Jesus Christ** who promised through the Apostle, John, *"If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be **FREE INDEED!**" John 8:36 (KJV)*

Those enrolled in the Otero Welcome Home curriculum do so acknowledging the expectation of attaining Complete freedom from their addiction. To participate you must agree to a period of one full year of the training, fellowship and worship programs offered by Otero Welcome Home whether living in the Otero Welcome Home residence or off campus. You must agree, for a period of at least one year, to:

1. Refrain from drugs unless prescribed by a licensed physician; and, from all alcoholic beverages of every kind.
2. Refrain from ALL pornography including reading materials, adult magazines, pornographic T.V., motion pictures, burlesque, strip shows and computer programs.
3. Refrain from the use of any inappropriate or demeaning language, regardless if it seems to be acceptable to the general public.
4. Refrain from any conversation that in any way encourages or promotes any of the above practices.
5. Refrain from all arguing, striving, debating, backbiting, bullying, cheating, abusing or fighting with one another; instead, loving and forgiving one another as God has loved and forgiven you. You must agree to bring every dispute or infringement of any of the above immediately to the attention of the Otero Welcome Home Administrator whose decision will be final.
6. Refrain from the use of all tobacco inside or within 30 ft. of any structure operated by Otero Welcome Home; or, any structure being utilized by Otero Welcome Home for any purpose. (However, smoking in the alley is permitted.)
7. Keep yourself clean, neatly groomed and suitably clothed at all times. Maintenance of both your personal space and all shared space is required at all times. Remember, how you look and act reflects on God.
8. Attend all Otero Welcome home Fellowship meetings each week to be held or attended as a group by Otero Welcome Home at a place of it's choice, and as a functional part of it's curriculum.
9. Attend all pre-scheduled Otero Welcome Home Worship and/or Christian Training meetings each week to be attended as a group. You will receive a calendar of these events which are a part of the Otero Welcome Home curriculum.
10. Allow unannounced and random drug and/or alcohol testing by any Otero Welcome Home representatives (this includes law enforcement officers) at any time/place.
11. Through personal testimony of the help you have received, encourage others to, "Get involved and **GET** Help!"
