

North and South Campground Guidelines and Rules



- You must have your "Back to the 50's" registration confirmation letter, BTT50s registration or your vendor packet at the time you enter the campground.
- Any vehicle newer than 1964 parked along the Snelling fence in the north campground that is not in a campsite will be towed. This area is for show cars only.
- All campers must be a registered "Back to the 50's" participant.
- No person under 18 years of age may register for a camp site.
- All camping units must be in the campgrounds on Thursday, there will not be any campers
 parked after 8:00 PM Thursday.
- No camping vehicles longer than 35' (total length) will be parked in the North campground.
- Campsites are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- Campers shall not be moved from their assigned sites, unless approved by the campground coordinators.
- Each camp site may have *up to* six additional campers.
- Only one camping unit is allowed per site, including tents. Having two tents on one site or a tent alongside a camper is not allowed.
- Car trailers, cargo trailers and car dollies are not allowed in the campground. If a camper needs to load, or unload, a car they will do this outside of the campground.
- Car trailers converted to campers must be pre-approved by campground coordinators.
- Quiet Time will be from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.
- One vehicle per camp site. Vehicle must line up with camper in the camp site. Extra vehicles need to be parked in the overflow lot.
- **North** No awnings will be allowed; easy up's can be used, but cannot be anchored down. **South** Awnings may be used (**south campground only**).
- Keep your campsite clean.
- Campers must wear wrist bands at all times.
- ATV's, bicycles, golf carts, mini bikes and scooters that are not street legal are not allowed in the campground.
- Visitors may enter only if accompanied by a registered camper. Visitors must be escorted by the camper to and from the gate.
- Generator operation is *not* allowed in the north campground.
- No show vehicles with camping trailers allowed into the show or into the campgrounds from the show. If you are camping in your vintage camping trailer, it stays in the campground.
- All parking permits and window stickers must be displayed in plain view.
- No open flame campfires allowed in campgrounds, this includes propane campfires.
- Speed limit not to exceed 15 mph.
- Power cords must meet or exceed power supply amps. Power supply cords must be minimum of 12/3 or larger. All supply cord connections must be 8" off the ground.
- Campers must leave a 3 ft. space in front of all electrical panels.
- \$35.00 fee for all returned checks.
- No pets are allowed in the campgrounds, leave your pets at home.
