
WELCOME!





SUNDAY SCHOOL - Entertainment for the kids, or a Matter of life or death?

For years, Sunday School has probably meant different things to different people. For many it's something we do on a Sunday morning hiving the children off to a separate room while we grown- ups have "our time" to be spiritually fed. Cute stories, trite crafts waved and dangled before doting parents after the meeting. Most kids can't even remember what they have been taught when asked what they learned about today in Sunday School. Often un-prepared teachers resort to keeping the kids 'entertained' whilst fervently watching the clock, wondering when the sermon will be over, often panicking how to keep them occupied if the sermon runs late. Is this your experience?

A few years ago one of our interns in New York was visiting some of the children on his route and went to one particular block. As he was making his way up to the apartment, he saw the kids out on the landing outside the apartment screaming. Our staff member knew something was wrong and hurried up to find that the mother who was pregnant had been murdered and the kids were home at the time.

Just a few weeks ago when Pastor Bill was ministering in the UK, we received a call to say one of our Sunday School kids who was sponsored, had been murdered in the middle of the night by her stepfather whilst the siblings looked on. Then just a few days after that, we received the news that another one of our kids and her mother were both strangled by a jealous ex-partner. This was less than a month ago folks...

The kids we minister to live in some of the roughest places in the world. We never know whether we will see our kids from one week to the next. That is why Sunday School to us is a matter of life and death. We are not just 'playing out' some cute Bible Story to keep them entertained. We prepare and teach with a passion and an urgency to get these kids under the sound of the gospel and reach them before it's too late.

Sunday School should be the most exciting place for kids, in that nothing else will dissuade them from wanting to be there. Imagine coming into a place where there are happy smiling faces greeting you and hugging you, upbeat music playing and an excitement in the air that you can almost touch. The clock ticks on and suddenly a deafening screaming countdown 10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1- and the whistle

blows! Following the greeting and introduction of the lesson, the place erupts in praise action songs with competitions to see who can sing louder – the boys or the girls. The atmosphere pulsates with energy. Kids feel safe. Kids feel loved. The roof almost lifts off with a fresh surge of euphoria as the games begin and the kids get a chance to win a prize. Boys cheering on the boy's team. Girls cheering on the girl's team. So much fun and laughter.

Then it is time for the preaching. The crescendo of noise cascades to a silence where you can hear a pin drop. A powerful lesson ensues taught through drama, object lessons and cartoon images, driving home one hard hitting principle each week and teaching the children how to apply it to their everyday lives. The lesson ends. No balloons popped – the children have been on their best behaviour, meaning they all get to receive the promotion that week. This week it's pizza! The chatter and banter begins again and songs of joy resound on the buses as the kids are taken home. Take me there now! Sounds more exciting than some adult meetings!

Who out there is going to get close enough to the heartbeat of God to hear the cries of the children and the cry of Father's heart? And who, having heard the cries, is willing to do whatever it takes to answer those cries while hearts are still beating. Yours and theirs! Time is running out. The need is the call and the children need to know the love of the Saviour.

Messianic Moment



Messianic Moment By Dr Howard Morgan

A Message for Pastors - Part ||

Having no power to manifest such "signs," the Jewish people would not be provoked to faith in Jesus as the Messiah. Since such provocation is intended to promote their faith in Jesus, which in turn, according to Romans 11:15 means the resurrection of the dead, which occurs at the time of the second coming of Christ. So we can see that this strategy is primary intended, not just to rob the Church of her inheritance in the rich root of this heritage, but in fact to try to block the return of the Lord by preventing the Jewish people from coming to faith in Jesus.

Historical Separation

As you know from your studies of church history, the Body of Christ has been experiencing a slow but steady restoration of biblical truths: the message of salvation by faith, the priesthood of all believers, the bible as the sole authoritative source of doctrine, its translation into the language of the people, baptism by immersion upon the confession of faith, the restoration of the gifts of the holy spirit, Church government based on anointing rather than institutional promotion, the restoration of all the equipping ministries of Ephesians 4, the commitment to fulfil the great commission, and many others.

These truths had to be restored because they were replaced by various "doctrines of demons" that had infiltrated and corrupted the Church throughout the centuries. I believe that one of the major reasons for the restoration of the Church to her Jewish Roots is so that the Church can be restored to her biblical relationship and responsibility to the Jewish people. The call upon the Church to provoke Israel to Jealousy is one of the truths of the New Testament that has historically been almost totally rejected. In thinking that they had to make the gospel more palatable to gentile audiences, men of good intentions, misdirected in their zeal to preach the Gospel, de-Judaized their message, and by doing so, opened themselves to the demonic doctrine of "replacement theology." This had the dual effect of separating the Church from her Roots in Israel's Olive Tree and promoting a spirit of arrogance toward the Jewish people. The Church no longer saw herself as part of the Jewish people or part of God's plan to provoke Israel to jealousy. Instead she grew into a "counterfeit imperialistic theocracy" that lost its authentic spiritual testimony and the ability to make genuine bornagain disciples. Authentic spirituality was replaced by a

hierarchical system of political and militaristic schemes that forced "loyalty" to a "Church" instead of genuine spiritual rebirth and new life. The more the Church rejected her "Olive Tree connection," the more she grew into institutionalized sacramentalism, hierarchicalism, spiritual darkness and unbelief. As time went by, what started as a Messianic Jewish faith based on the Scriptures and the power of God, became a thoroughly gentilized "Christianity" based on political and militaristic power and Church traditions that were in many instances nothing more than a "christianized paganism."

All things Jewish were slowly rejected and in some circumstances ultimately forbidden. The true Church was tragically compromised, once compromised, I believe that history shows she came under the judgment of God for disobeying the apostolic command not to be arrogant toward the unbelieving natural branches. Unable to provoke the Jews to faith in Christ, the devil inspired her to provoke the Jews to wrath, and further entrenched unbelief by centuries of malicious and incessant persecution. The Jewish people were branded in such ways as to sanctify their persecution, suffering, and even death. They were the innocent victims of hate filled theologies that bred spiritual disaster for the church and calamities for the natural sons of Abraham. This was a satanic strategy to keep the true gospel away from the Jewish people and thereby keep Jesus from returning, because their re-grafting into their own Olive Tree means the resurrection of the dead, which takes place when Jesus returns (Romans 11: 15).

Practical benefits for your Church

By recognizing that we are practicing a Jewish faith, as opposed to a traditional "Christian" one, we are freed from the historic, cultural and demonic entanglements that have robbed Christians of their scriptural inheritance for centuries. Whenever "tradition" stands in the way of renewal, whenever the voice is heard that says, "we don't do that in our Church," with the implication that our Church has a more holy or sacred tradition, a "Jewish Roots" orientation answers, "we are following the scriptures and obeying the revelation of God, not the traditions of men, no matter how old or ingrained they are!" After all, no Christian tradition is older than the Hebrew scriptures. Every aspect of our Christian life begins to be analyzed by this Jewish Roots orientation. Are we doing what we are doing in our Church or spiritual life because of our culture, our traditions, or because of our human philosophies? Is what we are doing according to the Word of God? Are we worshipping God the way he desires to be worshipped, the way the Scriptures teach He is to be worshipped, or the way we have been taught by our traditions? Are we in fact actually worshipping or merely have a "song service" (and we wonder why there is such a minimal presence of the Holy Spirit in most churches). Are we praying according to the spiritual principles of the Scriptures or according to our own human understanding. How many Christian are frustrated in their prayer lives? Is it because they have never been taught to pray according to the Bible? So many Christians are in fact victims of satanic

strategies that have replaced the teachings of the Hebrew scriptures with various non-scriptural traditions that the God of Israel neither respects, receives, nor responds to.

Let me reiterate, I am not saying that Christians should adopt Jewish traditions or try to imitate unbelieving Jews in their modern day religious practices. But a Jewish Roots understanding will insist on a scriptural basis for everything we do, say, and believe. Not only will we be encouraged to study the Scriptures, but we will also be encouraged to understand how the Jewish people throughout history have understood them, and be freed to glean from them riches of our own inheritance "among them" (Romans 11:17). This is something that Satan is desperately afraid of. He is terrified of the prospect of true believers entering into honest study of the Scriptures with the Jewish people. He knows the powerful witness that will be able to go forth, as well as the great treasures that will be opened to the Church.

A Jewish Roots understanding will cause your people to be more assiduous when they read the scriptures, by creating a mentality that says, "I want to know the truth...not the traditions of men." This will cause them, if they want to be disciples of the kingdom of God, to really dig into the word and truly "study to show themselves approved."

Many pastors ask, "Why is it important to say 'Jewish' instead of just 'Scriptural' or 'spiritual'? why is it necessary to continually put the word Jewish into our vocabulary?" It is important because of God's plan to use the Church to provoke natural Israel to jealousy. The Lord desires to restore to the Christian Church a mentality that causes her to be very self-conscious of the Scriptural fact that she has been grafted into a Jewish covenant, is believing in the God of Israel, is saved by the Jewish Messiah and is believing and obeying the Jewish scriptures. With the restoration of this mentality, of this understanding, the Church can begin to pray and act in such a way that her relationship with the Jewish people and the nation of Israel will finally, after so many centuries, take the form and shape that God intended from the beginning.

A Jewish Roots mentality also creates a barrier preventing demons from bringing their doctrines into the lives of your peoples. No other world view or philosophy - either natural or spiritual - than that which is according to the scriptures is accepted. We learn how to study together - with tolerance and mutual respect so that "iron can really sharpen iron." We test our personal or corporate interpretations and applications of the scriptures by examining the fruit it bears. Is it causing the individual to know God in a greater way and manifest more fruit of the Spirit? Jesus said, "You shall know them by their fruit"(Matt. 12:33)

By studying the Jewish Roots of the Christian faith, we gain a richer understanding of the Bible, of the person and ministry of Jesus, and the writing of the Jewish rabbi and apostle Paul. We can gain insight into the forms of worship and community life that the early church practiced, as we understand how the Jewish believers brought their Old Testament faith, traditions, and practices into the church. We can gain insight into how the early believers understood the practical dynamics of living out their faith in a hostile pagan world. We gain vital spiritual lessons as we study the Old Testament. We learn about the attributes of God, his nature and his ways with men. These studies will mature our walk with God. We will not be deceived into following a God that is constructed after our own imaginations or human traditions. Rather we learn how to relate to the God of Israel, as we study how He has dealt redemptively with real people, our spiritual ancestors by faith. We gain insight into the plans and purposes of God, as we study his dealings with the Jewish people and their responses to his laws, prophets and judgments. Among many other themes, we gain true understanding into the dynamics of faith, without which it is impossible to please God, and we learn about the true nature of covenant and how central this theme is to the purposes of God and his relationship to us.

God, who never changes, has left us a tremendous legacy in the Hebrew scriptures. This legacy, and the ministry fruit it is intended to produce, is lost to us when we fail to study our Jewish Roots and develop the Biblical relationship with the Jewish people God intends our churches to have.

Producer/Presenter Dreams for Living TV



Q1 Hi Richard thank you so much for taking time out to answer some questions for me. Firstly how did you come to know Jesus as your Lord & Saviour?

A Well I was 14 years old whenever I became a Christian. I was heavily involved in football. I was extremely committed like getting up at 5am in the morning, and I was talented at this, so much so I was scouted by Arsenal Football Academy. I was picked out of several youngsters to go to the next level, I believed in a God but I didn't have a personal relationship with him. I lived in London and we always, as a family, went to the Notting Hill Carnival. This particular year my older brother decided to meet us there and he would contact us whenever he got there, however, we heard nothing the entire day from my brother.

Anyhow, the next day I decided to have a nap and my brother walked in to my room. I said how was the carnival?' He replied that he hadn't gone to the camival, he stated he had gone to our aunt's house instead he said as he was on the way there he heard an audible voice speak to him to go to our aunt's house. He ignored it, then he heard it again and ignored it again, and finally he heard it a third time, by this time it was too tale to go to the carnival so he decided to go to our aunt's house, and obeyed the voice When he got there a lady was preaching the gospel message of Jesus. My brother really felt God's calling and gave his life to Jesus there and then. Now while my brother was relating this all to me I suddenly became very jealous and I asked God the question: 'How come you are calling him and not me?'

I told my brother this and he immediately replied 'I think God is calling you too'. Around two weeks later the lady was preaching in our auntie's house again and this time I went along with my 4 brothers and sisters We were all so committed by the message that all of us gave our lives to Christ at the very same moment! Right from that moment I was on fire for God, I had this amazing heat come all over my chest, and for some it can be a slower process but I had a zeal and hunger. Various pastors began prophesying all over the world about my life, my love for Christ increased, and then I had to make a big choice between my career and God. I really believed that God had called me for the ministry so I surrendered my love of football and the prospects of a glittering career for God. I started heading home groups at 14 years old and I gave my first sermon at 18

years, I completed a Bible College Degree in Theology and travelled to 10 different countries spreading the Word.

Q2 How did you come up with the idea for Dreams for Living TV?

I had a real passion for the ministry and for A preaching. However, for some reason I always had friends who were very influential figures. Then at 19 years I had a vision where I saw myself in a studio interviewing a new breed of people who live for God. These people were not bound by circumstances, and in the vision I was not just the presenter but the director as well! Now a very good friend of mine, Carl used to have what we would call our 'dream talk' time, we would jot down profiles of guests, put together a team - it was a crazy kinda faith going on! So I had this vision but no finances to forward it, then I shared my vision with the Director of Revelation TV, and he said he would do a deal with me and if I could raise a certain amount of money they would go ahead with the show - I said 'Yes!' trust me this was in faith. So I had to find this money, it wasn't a lot for broadcast media but it was a huge amount for me. Then a short while later I was out in the car with one of my friends and out of the blue he asked me about my 'dream show', I told him the current situation and then he replied 'I'll cover it!' I couldn't believe it Dreams for Living TV was born

Q3 How do you see the vision and work expanding?

A We have achieved and surpassed what we thought already, the vision is to reach the lost and a be a blessing for the kingdom. Mainstream TV is the ultimate goal, to be able to broadcast to the nation would be awesome...

Q4 Have you a particular interview that sticks in your mind?

The interview that sticks most in my mind is Α one with a lady who was like a daughter to the Ugandan President called Rosabelle. She is an extraordinary lady. She is not blood related but he treats her like a daughter. Her story is extraordinary, one time she was travelling on a private jet plane to Uganda but the plane crashed in the middle of a desert. The pilot died. There was nothing to eat or drink and the heat was stifling. The other survivors were resorting to cannibalism but in the middle of everything God spoke to Rosabelle. He told her to walk and to keep walking and he would save her. She ended up walking 100 miles against the elements with no food or water, gangrene had set in on her injured legs. She kept hearing this voice 'I am going to save you'. She was picked up and at the end of the day she was the only one to survive the crash! She was honoured by the President of Uganda.

Q5 You have just linked up with 3-in-1 Publishing and In Focus Interactive – how important is a strategic alliance such as this?

A I think that it is extremely important. What actually happened was one evening I was on my laptop and I heard God say to me that He was going to open up a door with a particular website. I searched different websites but nothing. Then following a conversation with another believer, the door opened up and I know it's the right door. 3-in-1 furthers the gospel of Christ and ministers to the wider audience. I really admire your vision with 3-in-1 The Voice and with writers, yes it is a very important alliance and relationship and reflects what we are doing in the broadcast media.

'I Have a Dream' – Martin Luther King Jnr Part 2 By Lianne Henderson

King Jr conversed with the highest of authority figures such as President John F. Kennedy and campaigned for President Lyndon B. Johnson. Martin Luther King Jr was arrested in a total of twenty times and was assaulted at least four times. In spite of all the hate that was coming his way it didn't stop him from earning five honorary degrees; named Man of the Year by *Time* magazine in 1963; and became not only the symbolic leader of American Blacks but also a world figure.

In 1964 Martin Luther King Jr at the age of 35 was the youngest man to have received the Nobel Peace Prize. When notified of his selection, he made a very generous announcement that he was turn over the prize money of \$54,123 to the future developments of the civil rights movement. In 1965 he led a campaign to register black people to vote. The same year the US congregation passed the Voting Rights Act outlawing all of the discriminatory acts that prevented black people voting in the South. As civil rights movements became increasingly radicalized, King found that his message of a peaceful protest was not shared by many of the younger generation. King began to protest against the Vietnam War and the poverty levels in the US. However on the evening of April 4th 1968, while standing on the balcony of his motel room in Memphis, Tennessee, where he was about to lead a protest march in sympathy with striking garbage workers of Tennessee, Martin Luther King Jnr was assassinated...his legacy lives on...in his words and works...

'I just want to do God's will. And he's allowed me to go to the mountain. And I've looked over, and I've seen the promised land! I may not get there with you, but I want you to know tonight that we as a people will get to the promised land.' Martin Luther King Jr

The more I examined the little girl's outfit and braided hair, I thought 'Ha! Obviously it is an important day for you', a birthday party perhaps or maybe they were getting ready to attend church – possibly Metro. Whatever the reason, photographs can tell us a lot; I thought to myself as I looked at it one thing was for sure, here is a woman who has made a huge effort to give her daughter the life she never had, sacrifices probably that will never be known to others, have been made. She had most certainly struggled against great odds to ensure that she got her to Sunday School – 'Wow!' I thought look at the difference Metro Ministries has made in their lives...

I asked Janine to forward a caption, and whenever I read her reply, I froze. It was as though someone had punched me in the stomach 'that can't be right!' I thought. The lady and the child in the picture had been two of the victims mentioned in the feature, both strangled by a jealous ex-partner. As the shock subsided it was replaced only by a mixture of dismay and righteous anger, and then as I began to study the photo more closely and re-read the caption, my dismay only gave way to tears...it takes a lot to make me cry, I have witnessed a lot in my life, but I felt the tragedy of this picture keenly. Here two lives had found a new hope in Jesus through the vital work of Metro Ministries, only for the promise of that hope to be cruelly stolen from them with the finality that death brings...

I truly believe that Father allows us to see how His heart is breaking over things sometimes and it is usually about people and issues that we would normally skim over. When He does this it not only breaks our hearts but shows up I believe our inadequacies and humbles us. God doesn't skim over anything, every soul, every life is important to Him - it is sacred.

JESUS COMMANDS ALL CHRISTIANS TO BE IN THE MEDIA!

I got involved in radio at the age of 15, making the tea and helping out around the studio. But I was regularly disheartened growing up, as it appeared that Christians were actively discouraged from getting involved in the media. They frowned on the press and as for being a radio or TV presenter, or dare I even say a club DJ... well that was just seen as sinful! In comparison, looking at the ministry of Jesus - the dodgy "worldly" types he hung out with, the then non-Biblical things he said and the shocking antisocial activities he did, I wonder if churches or Christians that think like this would really accept Christ if his earthly ministry was in the 21st century!

"Wise up! How on earth can you claim that Jesus commands us to be in the Media??"

Jesus' parting words were quite direct! They were to his closest friends, the guys who followed him and trusted him - the disciples. These young lads in their teens and twenties were seen as a motley bunch. In those days the top guys in class were taken on by a rabbi as their disciples like interns or apprentices. The rejects would return to the family businesses. Although Jesus gave the instructions directly to them, they were intended for ALL his followers- i.e us.

Did he ask us to "prayerfully consider" – NO! Did he suggest we form a committee and gather to pray or support others – NO! He said GO... DO! It was a direct challenge and unambiguous command. It's recorded for us in the Bible (Matthew 28:19) where he commanded us ALL to become News Reporters or Broadcast Journalists! He even told us how to do it... Using all methods available- TV, radio, print-media and word of mouth, broadcast the "Good News" at a local community level, regional level, nationally and then internationally!

Now before you dash out and resign from your job or change your University course to Media Studies. We can be good Broadcast Journalists with a little experience and without media training... Although a full time presenter, my qualifications are in Civil and Structural Engineering - handy!!

I've never studied Media Studies; never done a course on "How to be a Radio Presenter". It was more like-"this is a studio, those are the buttons you need to press and oh - you're on in 5 mins!" Thrown in at the deep end and learning to swim very quickly: sometimes this is the best way to learn!

In some ways this could be a bit like being a Christiantake the leap and the learning curve starts from there! If a sales executive has had their life changed by a product, they'll have no trouble selling it to others based on their own personal experience! This is how we can be "Good News" reporters.

As a 'Good News' reporter, what can I learn from a good News Reporter?


Well, a top News Presenter...

A Voice in the

The Sanctuary

There are sporadic times when you find yourself in circumstances that you recognise to be deeply significant. Sometimes, in these circumstances, the presence of God is so comprehensible it results



in a peculiar feeling of excitement mixed with an uneasy fear – for there is absolutely no doubt in whose presence you stand. Such encounters have nothing to do with our planning or control, they occur at the times and a place of God's choosing. This was the position whilst recently visiting sexually exploited children with members of the Ratanak team in Cambodia where we were in a deeply depraved area on the edge of Phnom Penh internationally renowned for the sexual exploitation of very young children.

On leavening the Kids Club we were been shown around a large disused building on the main street of Svay Pak. This was no ordinary building, it was the largest and most audacious building in the community. This four storey premises was built as a full service live in sex hotel where international paedophiles and sex tourists could visit and destroy young lives to their hearts' content. However, it now stood in the community as a huge monument to the loathsome intentions of evil men as the building was never finished and it never fulfilled its intended purpose. Due to international pressures, increased police activity and the increased influence of Christian projects in the community, the hotel was deemed, by its owners, to be too high a risk to put into operation. As a result, construction work was stopped with about 85% of the building completed.

Ratanak has long been committed to changing this darkest of neighbourhoods known around the world for its child sex slavery, but it is fair to acknowledge that this is no easy task to accomplish. For a long time we have prayed, and continue to pray, for God's presence and redemption to be made known in this impossibly broken community.

Several years ago it became self evident that having a permanent ministry location right in the middle of the child brothels would not only be helpful but would actually be fundamental to the success of any long-term program for change. To that end an old, closed down brothel building was rented and converted into a community centre from which a medical clinic, daily children's club and church would operate. This building, known as Rahab's House, has been of tremendous service and a remarkable success but has now become overwhelmed by the increasing demands made by so many desperate and broken lives. The need to enlarge this work was unmistakable - but how?

We have been privileged to witness many changes in this district already. Many signs of hope continue to appear amongst the hopelessness of this brothel community.

As we stood inside gazing around I was told of how it had come up for sale at a very reasonable price. As a team we didn't even have to look at each other. This building had "chosen" written all over it. It was as if the destiny of this building was indeed pre-ordained and evidence to the fact that the King was intent on taking up residence.

And so within days whilst still in Cambodia and without a budget, in fear and in faith we committed to buy this building. God, true to form, immediately provided the funds for the purchase and as of 30th October 2009 we became the owners of the largest building in the district. The size and location of the building make it a wonderful statement of redemption and hope available through Christ for those who suffer in the brothels which surround the property. We have taken to calling it *"The Sanctuary"* a fitting name.



The Sanctuary had been left dormant for several years and stood as workers left it when they stopped construction. While the major structure was largely complete there was much work to be done to make the building serviceable. The incomplete condition of the building was actually advantageous for us allowing us to finish the construction according to the needs as opposed to restricting programs to a building

constructed for a very different and grotesque purpose.

On an emotional and spiritual level it is also advantageous to take over a building that was never actually used in the destruction of young lives. This facility does not have a previous reputation or traumatic memories for the children of the community. So in every way this will is a new building, a new start and a new hope for the community. In every way we see this building as being the very best case scenario for ministry in Svay Pak. It almost seems like it was built for us!

This position was ratified during a structural survey. The report found that the foundations were laid in such a manner that they would support almost any building. As tests were made it was quickly established that floors 1,2,4 and 5 were adequate and floor 3 described as being able to support a significant load way stronger than would be expected. Little did the engineer realise that this was the floor where the church will be held and needed to be the strongest. The evidence of the hand of God on a work has never been more unmistakable as it has been with this building.

The building has since been totally remodelled and a 5th floor added to make it even larger and more striking. It has been turned into a into a school, medical clinic for the community and a church The 5th floor provides much needed staff quarters where Christian pastoral staff and workers, both local and expatriate, live and serve the community 24/7. The development of this site means that our neighbouring location of Rahab's House can now operate as a safe day care centre and enable community members to seek



employment options outside of Svay Pak's brothel industry in the assurance that their children are being well looked after.

Teams from Canada, Australia and the US worked tirelessly to complete the structure and add the fifth floor. The rooms were decorated and prepared ready to accept the 200 children who have registered for the school. A school that will offer free tuition to those who would otherwise never have had this opportunity, providing the hope of changed

lives and giving wings to dreams of careers once seen as out of reach. Partnerships are currently being formed with NGOs skilled in educational development that will be assisting in establishing a school curriculum best suited to the particular needs of the children of this district. There is much anticipation as we develop the programs that will serve the spiritual, emotional, physical and educational needs of this district. The local Cambodian pastoral and youth ministry team are already in place in the community ready to take up their expanded duties that the new facility will allow.

The third floor auditorium houses the church. A church under the leadership of a local man and his wife that has grown from nothing to over 300 members inside 12 months. A church where Sunday services are attended by drug addicts and pushers together with former and current sex workers and pimps. A place where the presence of God is invading lives and radically changing them as choices are made to turn away from illicit trades.

On Tuesday 25th May 2010 hundreds of guests sat in 42 degrees of heat to witness the formal opening of *The Sanctuary*. The Cambodian Minister of State for Religion made the formal opening speech sharing how Cambodia is a Buddhist nation but that all faiths are welcome. As he drew to the close of his written dialogue he looked up to the gathered crowd and, to the surprise of many, shared how he had received Christ as his own personal Saviour some months ago now and how he was being encouraged in this journey by the team responsible for *The Sanctuary*. So - when you find yourself in one of those oftentimes indescribable situations where God leads you down a path where the end is out of sight - be heartened that He has ALL things in the palm of His hand.

How can you help?

- Pray for those who work in this centre for wisdom to deal with the situations they face.
- Pray for those who visit that the love of God would invade their lives.
- Pray for the Minister of State for his continued growth in Christ.
- Pray for the children who are so violently abused around this area.
- Consider becoming a financial supporter of The Ratanak Foundation.



HOW GOD HEALED ME FROM ME AFTER 10 YEARS!

I was diagnosed with ME/CFS in 2001. I had previously been fit and healthy, bringing up 2 children with my husband as well as working as a home help.

Since 2001, I spent almost all of my time searching for answers, treatment and of course healing. This illness sent me and my family to despair. I read endless books, searched the internet, watched hundreds of religious TV programmes and attended many meetings and healing services.

In 2009 I was led to a woman's meeting in my home town. I met two ladies there whom I believe have played an integral part in my healing. Over the following few months the two ladies visited me in my home several times. Most importantly, they led us in prayer and during these moments, I was able to release many negative issues that I had been clinging on to. These were difficult times but after each occasion, I felt I was giving up "stones" that I had been unconsciously storing up.

After one of the visits, we discussed a ministry called SOZO that was planning a visit to Northern Ireland in May 2010. The conference that SOZO were about to lead was centred on releasing folk from the curses of Freemasonry and other brotherhoods. Some of the men in my family had sworn oaths to local lodges and I felt that the conference could help me on my road to recovery.

I attended the conference and realised that the healing that God promised had been stalled by curses and allegiances sworn by others, who really did not know or understand fully what they were doing. The personal ministry I received highlighted some final issues and I can positively assure you that from that moment my healing became whole and everlasting. Praise God.

THE PROPHET, THE APOSTLE AND THE PROTESTOR

The Prophet lived 2600 years ago, the Apostle wrote letters to the early churches around 60 AD, most of them preserved in what we now call the New Testament, and the Protestor is alive and well, in charge of a Christian church in East Belfast. Mysteriously the three met a week or two ago, no one really knows where or when, but those close to the Protestor suggest that it could have been one of those rare occasions when it had occurred to him that there might be more truths in the Bible than stored up in the libraries and Lecture Halls of the 'Whitfield College of the Bible' where he earned his stripes. The Protestor did most of the talking at this unusual meeting, and you couldn't fail to notice the sadness in the faces of the Prophet and the Apostle as he laid out his beliefs about the Law of Moses, in particular, the importance of observing the 'Lord's Day.'

'You claim your life's work is based on the teachings of the Bible,' said the Prophet, 'but there's so much of it you seem to know nothing about!'

'What do you mean?' protested the Protestor.

'Over two thousand years ago I foretold a day when the laws that are so central to your church would pass away. And yet... what were you doing outside that old building in Belfast last week?'

'And the banner you carried,' chipped in the Apostle, 'it said something about keeping the Sabbath Day holy. What did you mean by that?' 'The Fourth Commandment!' proclaimed the Protestor. 'Remember the Sabbath Day... do you want me to tear that page out of my Bible?'

'I've already torn it from your Bible,' said the Apostle hardly able to believe what he had just heard. 'I tore it out when I wrote to the Christians in Ephesus; "...if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under law.""

'You don't know what the people in my church are like,' complained the Protestor. 'If I don't control them they'll run wild. There's no telling what they'll end up doing!'

The River Jordan



In this month's issue, we will take a look at the River Jordan. The River Jordan is a river which flows directly to the Dead Sea in Southwest Asia. This beautiful river is one of the world's most sacred rivers and in Judaism, the river serves as the eastern border as the Land of

Israel, or the "Eretz Yisra'el". This is also the place where the Lord Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist.

There is significant Biblical importance to the River Jordan. In the Hebrew Bible, the River Jordan is related to a source of fertility to a large plain ("Kikkar ha-Yarden"), and the text is also said to be the "Garden of God" (Genesis 13:10). You may look at the Hebrew Bible on the following link

However, there are no regular descriptions of the River Jordan in the Bible. There are only a few references about the River Jordan in the Bible. When you look at Genesis 32:11 and Genesis 32:23-24, it shows that Jacob crossed the river and its tributary, known as the Jabbok (or the modern Al-Zarga) in order to reach Haran. The River Jordan in Biblical history appears as the scene of several miracles. The first miracle was when the Israelites crossed over the river near Jericho under Joshua, (Joshua 3:15-17). Later, the two tribes and the half tribe that settled in the east of the Jordan built on its banks, a large altar. This was known as a "witness" between them and the other tribes (Joshua 22:10 and 22:26). The Jordan was also crossed on dry ground by Elijah and Elisha (2 Kings 2:8 and 2:14). Elisha performed two other miracles at the Jordan by healing Naaman by having him bathe in its waters, and the second miracle that Elisha carried out was making an axe head of one of the "children of the prophets" float by throwing a piece of wood into the water of the River Jordan (2 Kings 5:14 and 6:6).

In the New Testament, it states that John the Baptist baptised unto repentance in the River Jordan, this can be read in Matthew 3:5-6, Mark 1:5, Luke 3:21 and John 1:28. The Lord Jesus The Christ, came to be baptised by John the Baptist there which you can read in Mark 3:13, Mark 1:9 and Luke 3:21, 4:1. The River Jordan is also the place where John the Baptist bore the record of Jesus as the Son of God, and the Lamb of God, John 1:29-36.

The New Testament speaks in several occasions about Jesus crossing the River Jordan during his ministry, Matthew 19:1 and Mark 10:1, and The New Testament speaks several times about Jesus crossing the Jordan during his ministry (<u>Matthew 19:1</u>; <u>Mark 10:1</u>), as well as believers crossing the river to hear him preach and to be healed of diseases, Matthew 4:25 and Mark 3:7-8. When the enemies of Jesus were out to capture him, He took refuge at the River Jordan in the place where John first baptised Him.

Even to this day, in Yardenit, which is located just south of the Sea of Galilee, there are many pilgrims that gather from around the world to immerse them, and to be baptized in the River Jordan.


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
