As we come to you today, this marks ONE YEAR since we have been in the field. ONE YEAR. This is not okay with us as the needs are still there, even more so now with the pandemic. We are hoping to be able to return to Guatemala in November but until then, the needs are growing, will you help us?

We need:

FUNDS! In Guatemala, there is a feeding program at the local mission church in Sajcavilla. In this pandemic, the teachers from the community have been gathering regularly at the church to teach the children and feed them. The church is paying the teachers and feeding the kids, who otherwise would go hungry. They currently have about 50-75 kids on any given day. This requires about \$500 month.



We also need: Medical Supplies (Generic Brands accepted)

We are asking for your prayers and your support with these needs. If you can fit this into your budget to help, we would be most grateful. The needs of the people are extreme. The greatest way we can show people Jesus is by our love.
