

We are entering the final months of 2022. As we look to the coming holiday season, I am very pleased to share with you we are planning

for trips in 2023. Our desire is to build at least ten teams for the coming year to meet needs in a variety of locations. In Guatemala, we are very excited to be joining Patty Ajanel, our long time friend and primary translator, in her hometown of Xela. We will be partnering with her church and staff to help grow their impact through community work, assisting in their school and discipleship homes, and new ventures into Huehuetenago! We will continue our work alongside Jerusalen Church in Los Pinos as well in the future. It's a time of great anticipation as we prepare to rejoin our brothers and sisters in Guatemala.

In addition to our work in Guatemala, we are building teams for Peru. The work among indigenous people of the high Andes Mountains offers a glimpse into a unique mountain culture similar to Nepal. The communities are remote and in need of the Gospel. In the Cusco area, our partner ministry leads a house church network and a training facility for leaders and a unique life and work program. In the mountain town of Cachora, we work alongside an orphanage under the direction of our partners at Zona Zegura. At the orphanage, teams are involved in a variety of ministry outlets to the children and staff as well as outreach to the community and local school.



We will also be building teams for Slovenia and Mexico in 2023. In Slovenia

we are assisting long term missionaries, Wade and Joan Killingsworth, with a church plant in a town outside of the capital city. Slovenia is a small country with major spiritual poverty. Many there have never read a Bible or heard the story of the Gospel. In Mexico we are partnering with Calvary

Tizimin in the Yucatán to encourage a young church seeking to reach its community. This little rural town is responding to the kindness of God being demonstrated by a small group of




committed believers. Our work is focused on encouraging the church and assisting with outreach events that invite the community to hear and see the Gospel. Added to this list or partners we hope to return with a few teams to Navajo land in New Mexico and work along side Pastor Aaron and the ministries of Tohatchi Baptist Church on the reservation.

These are all exciting opportunities for us. However, without all of you joining us, we can't walk with these brothers and sisters in the field of harvest.
