

If we seek to look more like Jesus, it will drive us toward the Father and into intentional intimate time with Him. When

that takes place evangelism becomes a natural outflow of our daily journey and we become intentional witnesses just like we are instructed to be in Scripture. This is our primary calling and



purpose as we remain here waiting for the final days to come.

So, I want to challenge you to consider joining a trip in 2024, getting involved in some intentional evangelism training, and allow the Lord to put you face to face with people who need to hear the Good News! Join us as we continue to reach the world and teach the Word in every occasion He provides. Begin now to prepare for the opportunities that are waiting for you in the coming months!
