City Fireworks Rules

Personal Fireworks are part of many Independence day Celebrations in Churchill Downs. But did you know that if you light them after 11 PM you might incur a large fine and have them confiscated by the police?

Legally you may only use them the day before, the day of and the day after a federal holiday and only between 8AM and 11PM"

Legal dates be July 3, 4 and 5 and September 6, 7 and 8 this year. On any other date this summer they are prohibited by city ordinance.

The Police and Fire departments will be working to enforce the ordinance. If you see fireworks after 11PM, you are within your rights to call the non-emergency Police number.

other safety tips

- Only use fireworks from licensed outlets
- Adults should light most fireworks
- Adults should supervise older children using fireworks
- Young children should never handle fireworks
- Light them a safe distance from houses and onlookers
- Do not light them in the street
- Do not relight any malfunctioning device
- Do not ignite in a container
- Never allow horseplay with fireworks.
- Keep a spare bucket of water or hose handy just in case.
