Leaf Pickup

Churchill Downs is full of trees. Every year those trees shed their leaves. Unless you have special permission you cannot burn leaves in the city of Lansing. If you put them in plastic bags you will need a private hauler because the city will not accept them packed that way. However, the City Public Service Department will accept them in paper yard bags on the regular trash pickup dates, provided you do so before the last pickup date. This year that date is November 28. Also you should NOT rake leaves into the street. The city does not allow this activity as it tends to clog up storm sewer drains.
