Dreams for Wainwright Park

Wainwright Park feels like it extends all the way from Stillwell Ave to Wainwright Ave, even though the eastern half of it (including the playground) is owned by the Lansing School District, not Lansing Parks and Rec. North of the playground, on the school district property, is a degraded pavement space which used to include a basketball court. In our November meeting, a neighbor on Hepfer brought up their desire to see this old pavement put to better use. Several ideas were mentioned, including making it back into a basketball court (which had some resistance due to the issues we have had with basketball courts in the past), adding tether ball, skateboarding or dirt biking course, or even just ripping it up and turning it back to grass.
