III. Bringing it Home - Questions to Ponder

Second, boasting in afflictions is counter-intuitive and certainly countercultural. Can you look back to times of suffering and see how they increased your perseverance, character, and hope?
Third, think about the depth of God's love demonstrated on Jesus' cross. How does that truth affect your trust in His ongoing love for you?
Fourth, how can you best share the truth of God's love for sinners with others?
