Warranty:

T-Corp. Warranties the surface of steel or cast iron bathtubs refinished by us against defects in workmanship or materials for a period of 1 year, providing the customer has properly maintained the bathtub as recommended. Warranty does not cover trip charges and rates will apply. Repairs due to defect in material or workmanship will be made free of charge during this time. This warranty does not cover damages caused by negative drains, dripping faucets, bath mats, abrasive cleaners, chipping due to direct impact, misuse or neglect. We also do not warranty against damages caused by surface. There is no guarantee that the color, once selected by the customer, will match other fixtures. There is no charge for labor or materials during the term of this warranty, providing the customer has properly maintained the bathtub as recommended. There will be a service charge for transportation or travel to and from your home. This warranty is non-transferable, and is null and void when the property is sold. This warranty covers steel or cast iron BATHTUBS only, not fiberglass. All other refinishing such as kitchen sinks, bathroom sinks, tile grout, counter tops, spot repairs, appliances, etc., will carry an absolute NO warranty. Bathtubs with corrosion and rust problems will be repaired to the best of our ability. It is impossible to warranty any further corrosion or rust problems. This warranty is in lieu of any other warranty expressed or implied.

Care Recommendations:

1. Do not use refinished surface for 24 hours.
2. Bathtubs must be caulked after a 24 hour period.
3. Remember new finish is tender for 10 days.
4. Never use abrasive cleaners.
5. Never use bath mats.
6. Faucets must be maintained at all times (never dripping).
7. Never let soap or shampoo bottles stand on a bathtub surface for long periods of time.
8. Never let dyes, drain opening solutions or any other chemical stand on bathtub surface.
9. Shower door installation and removal is at your own risk.

Cleaning Instructions:

Use only non-abrasive, liquid cleaners on your T -Corp. Refinishes surface. Spray cleaners such as Formula 409, Fantastic, or any liquid cleaner which does not contain abrasives, bleach or chlorine may be used. For best results, spray the surface and let it penetrate for 3-5 minutes before wiping. A "Tuffy" scrub pad or any plastic cleaning pad designed for use on Teflon surfaces works well. Extend the life of your refinishes surface with the use of "Gel Gloss" (available at most super markets) or any polymer based polish every six months.
