



# **AFRO-DESCENDANT Nation-Compact of Confederation**

## **Articles of Confederation**

### **Preamble**

The purpose of the Confederation is to establish a firm and never-ending league of friendship with each other, for our common recognition, economy, defense, the security of our liberties, and our mutual and general welfare, binding ourselves to assist each other, against all force offered to, or attacks made upon them, or any of them, because of race, religion, sovereignty, trade, or any other pretense whatever.

The signatories agree herewith to sit among each other in parliament and to have a government to government relationship with the United States in Free Association as an insular government.

- I. Each Confederate member among the Tribes, Nations, Freedmen, Churches, Mosques, Hebrews creates their own Tribal sovereignty among the Confederation of Afro-Descendant Tribes herewith known as “The Afro-descendant Nation Confederated-USA with freedom of expression, religious rights, and every power, jurisdiction, and right, which is not expressly reserved by this Confederation.
- II. Every entity and person in the Confederation will enjoy mutual friendship and intercourse among the people of the different cities, communities, and peoples of this union. If a crime is committed in the Confederation and the perpetrator flees to another part of the Confederation, he will be extradited to and tried in the authority in which the crime was committed.

- III. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to establishing an Indigenous Educational System
- IV. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to establishing a Banking and Treasury system
- V. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to establishing an Independent Criminal Justice System of Courts, Jails, and the Police Authority
- VI. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to establish a common defense by the establishment of a National Guard
- VII. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to establishing a Confederate Housing System
- VIII. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to the Highest Standards of Health and Welfare
- IX. Every entity and person in the Confederation Commit to paying National and local taxes as agreed upon by the majority of the Parliament.
- X. Each tribe, Nation, organization, association, Denominations will be allocated at least one vote in the Congress of the Confederation and more per their populations which are entitled to a delegation of between one and seven members.
- XI. Members of Congress are to be elected by their respected tribes, organization, association, or nation.
- XII. No congressman may serve more than two terms of three years.
- XIII. Only the central government may declare war, or conduct foreign political or commercial relations.
- XIV. No Confederacy may accept foreign gifts or titles or grant any title of nobility in response to favor that is harmful to the joint members of the Confederacy.
- XV. No city, tribe or local political authority may form any sub-national groups of Authority
- XVI. No tribe, Nation, organization, association, Denominations or Local Political Authorities of the Confederacy May Federally tax or interfere with the Federal Confederation's taxing power.
