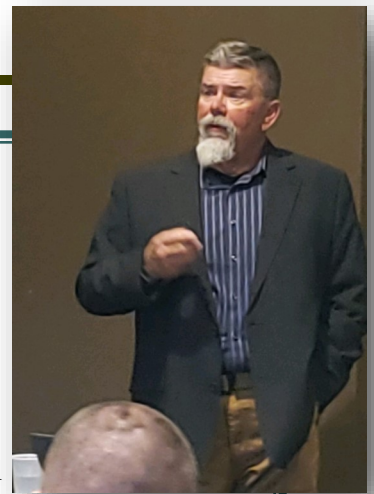

Employing the above-named employee shall hold MTU 13 and Charleston Police Department harmless as to any injuries or damages incurred by said employee as a result of such training, operations, function, references provided and/or other activities sanctioned by MTU 13 and the Charleston Police Department, regardless of fault or negligence on the part of any official or employee of MTU 13 or the Charleston Police Department, except for gross neglect or willful, wanton or intentional misconduct.

The above employer shall further agree to indemnify MTU 13 and the Charleston Police Department in the full amount o fany judgement or claim awarded to the trainee, his/hers heirs. Dependents and assigns fro such injuries or damages sustained by said trainee during the official course of his or her temporary assignment to MTU 13 training, except for gross negligence or willful , wanton or intentional misconduct.

It is further agreed that, should suit or claim be filed by said trainee alleging injury or damage as a result of MTU 13's training, operations, functions, referenced provided and/or other activities sanctioned by MTU 13 and the Charleston Police Department, reasonable notice of such suit or claim will be given to the department or agency employing the affected trainee; and said department or agency will appear and defend MTU 13 and the Charleston Police Department.

Nothing agreed to herein by any of the parties hereto shall constitute a waiver of any statutory or other immunities available to the parties under Illinois law.
