PURPOSE:

This course is designed to met the Illinois mandate for School Resource Officers refresher. There shall be a continuing educational requirement for those holding a specialty SRO certificate. Within the two-year period after issuance, each SRO must complete as least one course within the three general topic areas: Juvenile Law, Officer and Youth Interactions and School Threat Response.

DESCRIPTION:

This refresher course consists of the three primary components addressed in the curriculum: Juvenile Law, Officer and Youth Interactions, and School Threat Response. Each component will be taught by a professional who is an expert in his/her field of law enforcement. The following chart outlines the three components of the school resource refresher course.

No Shows/Cancellation Policy
