<u>**Pool Keys-</u>**New pool keys are still available for pick up. The old cards will not work this year. Call to make arrangements if unable to pick up during business hours.</u>

<u>A/C Reminder</u>-With warm weather approaching it's important to tend to your a/c line. Pour a cup of bleach or vinegar and a cup of warm water down the a/c line in your closet every month during the summer months. This will prevent a potential clog and leak on your neighbors below. Put a plastic container under the line to catch any water that could leak, and randomly check it. It is recommended you purchase a Flood Buzz alarm to let you know when you have a water leak! This will save you and your neighbor a lot of headaches! You can purchase them on line or check with your local hardware store.

Pets-Please remember to take your pets to the dumpster side. Pets are not permitted in the common areas, that includes first floor patio areas. Gates and tie outs are not permitted, and will be taken without notice if they are in the common area. If your pet damages the grass, you will be responsible for replacement costs. Please use pet stations and bags provided by Woodland Hills for pet owners to clean up. If you do not clean up you will be fined \$60.00 per occurrence. You will only receive one warning then a fine. Thank you to all responsible pet owners.

Polling location-We received communication that Woodland Hills will not be used as a polling location this year for voting. Woodland Hills residents will now cast their votes at the Wilder City Building at 520 Licking Pike.

Inspections-Yearly inspections will begin shortly. Please make sure your patio's cleaned up from the winter months. If you have clouded windows, ripped screens or broken blinds they need to be replaced.

<u>FYI-</u>The Pool deck at pool # 1 is scheduled to be replaced in April. Weather permitting, the pool will be finished and ready Memorial Day weekend. With summer approaching it's a good idea to refamiliarize with the pool rules.
