#### Board Meeting Notes

- The Board meeting was held January 23, @ 3.00pm. Board meetings are generally every fourth week of the month with the exception of July and December, (no meetings).
  - Management updated the Board of the drainage work progress through out the property. The main issues are currently completed. Exercise area storm water pipe replaced, French drain installed, trash racks installed, between 52-54 storm drain pipe replaced, 54 - 58 French drain install, 58 Trash racks installed. 62-64 downspout drainage completed. We do have a few more areas that need to be completed.
    - The board reviewed the landscape plans & quotes provided by Dave Basinger, and they approved the plans for this year.
  - We have a new cleaning company this year looking forward to working with them. You should see a noticeable difference in the hallways soon.

#### Important Rule Reminder
