Please join us at the event center **Saturday April 15<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 PM.** The Arc Mission will be hosting a special guest speaker.

Dennis Slane from Ozarks Dutch Oven Group will be here to demonstrate the basic "Beginners 101" class on cooking with cast iron. He will be using a couple of cast iron Dutch ovens to bake a cake, and show how to regulate temperatures using hot coals. Dutch ovens are not the only tool you can cook with, big cauldrons are used to boil water, or cook a big pot of ham 'n' beans, fry fish or use a skillet to fry up some breakfast viddles like bacon, hash browns, and biscuits. Possibilities are endless! Make sure your prepared to cook a meal for your family. Besides outdoor cooking is fun!

He has recipes available ranging from appetizers, breads, main dishes, to desserts. My personal favorite is the dinosaur eggs!


