

**VILLAGE OF CHAUNCEY**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - 4**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE DRINKING WATER SOURCE  
PROTECTION PLAN OF OCTOBER, 2014**

**WHEREAS;** The US EPA in conjunction with the OHIO EPA have developed a program for the Village of Chauncey pursuant to the 1996 Amendments to the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act for the assessment and protection of source water for public drinking sources, and,

**WHEREAS;** The OHIO EPA has worked with the Village of Chauncey under the OHIO EPA'S "Developing Local Drinking Water Source Protection Plans in Ohio (2003).";

**WHEREAS;** The Village of Chauncey and OHIO EPA have issued "DRINKING WATER SOURCE PROTECTION PLAN for The Village of Chauncey", PWS ID # 0500512 dated October 2014 (DWSPP), and;

**WHEREAS;** The Village of Chauncey has committed to reviewing the DWSPP every year beginning with January 1, 2016;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Chauncey, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section One: The DRINKING WATER SOURCE PROTECTION PLAN-PWS ID #0500512 dated October 2014 is hereby adopted as the Water Source Protection plan for the Village. The Fiscal Officer shall make the DWSPP available at Village Hall during normal working hours for review by the Village water users, by residents of the Village, by Village officials and by any interested person.


Section Two: The Village Administrator shall issue the news release and information letter recommended in Appendix D of the DWSPP as soon as he is able to do so, but not later than 60 days from the date of enactment of this Ordinance.


Section Three: The Village Administrator shall cause to be printed the brochure recommended in Appendix E for distribution to the water users of the Village water system and to all residents of the Village as may be appropriate not more than 30 days after issuance of the press release and information letter referred to above.

Section Four: It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Village Administrator in consultation with the Village water plant licensed operator to implement the DWSPP within the Village, to update and make changes to the DWSPP as may be necessary, to issue reports required under the DWSPP and to update the Village Council on the status of the DWSPP on or before the February regular Council meeting of each year hereafter.


Section Five: This Ordinance dealing, with the drinking water safety of the Village water supply system, being necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the water users and residents of the Village with regard to being informed about the protection from pollution, contamination and other disturbances of the Village water supply system, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure that shall take effect immediately upon enactment.


