ORDINANCE NO. 2016 -57-

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT VILLAGE
ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the current Village Administrator has resigned to take a better position, but is willing to work as a consultant to the Village to teach his skills to a current employee who will become an assistant to the Village Administrator and to a new Village Administrator to be appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Chauncey, State of Ohio, as follows:


Section One: There is created the position of Assistant Village Administrator in the Village, who shall be either part-time or full-time as the Mayor, based on the needs of the Village, in his prudent discretion determines.

Section Two: Because of the need to provide continuing municipal services to the residents of the Village during the transition period of appointment of a new Village Administrator, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency and will take effect immediately upon passage.




