1. Looking through the actions of the New Testament church and the instructions of the inspired writers/apostles, name the acts of worship for Jesus' church.

2. Is there a way to determine how often (or on what day or days) the church assembled for worship? How do you know? Is there also a way to determine the importance of worship assemblies for the church? How did the inspired writers view the relationship of Christians to the assemblies?

3. The Lord's Supper is one of the most notable differences between the church of Christ and denominations. What is this act of worship? What is the significance? Are we free to use any elements? Also, when is the Lord's Supper to be observed?

4. What kind of music does God want today in worship? How do you know? Instrumental music is used for worship in denominations and sometimes by congregations of the Lord's church. Is this right? Why or why not? What arguments are often used to support the use of other types of music/singing in worship? How would you answer?
