I am so grateful for a grant from the Great Plains Conference that will cover the costs of this renewal leave, and the resources they've provided for our transition to a single Leadership Board model as well as for so many who have said "yes" to the Spirit's prodding to try new things. I am filled with joy and excitement and hope for not only the time to tend my own soul but also for what God is doing with this time in the life of our congregation!


