

Bishop Wilson adjourns his first Great Plains Annual Conference

The recent Great Plains Annual Conference adjourned on June 10 th. It began online on May 31, with a special session that include approving the disaffiliation of 157 churches out of the <u>960 congregations</u> affiliated with this district. The in-person session, held in La Vista, NE., began Wednesday night.

The 2024 conference of \$15,124,101, a decrease of about \$672,000 or 4% from the 2023 budget, was approved Saturday morning. Rev. Amy Leypoldt, present of the conference council on Finance and Administration (CF&A), said half of the mission shares from disaffiliated churches, about \$552,000 would be included in the '24 budget.

Earlier, Lippoldt said CF&A had approved \$500,000 for the conference congregational excellence department to provide support for churches ad individuals whose congregations had been split by disaffiliation votes.

After a successful amendment, the conference approved a plan to increase racial-ethnic diversity in conference leadership on committees, teams, and boards. The original resolution asked for 24% of each group to be persons of color by 2028, then amended to being equal to or greater than the percentage of color in Kansas and Nebraska. According to the 2020 census, Kansas's percentage of white population is 75.6%. In Douglas County, it is 76%, with 24% of the county's population in the diversity index.

Also approved was a resolution titled "Building Bridges, Not Walls," that pledged continued support and guidance for refugees entering the country.

Most Current Financial Update (Note: this is posted after the Minutes of the previous month have been approved)

The 2023 budget is \$175,503.00 (with the average monthly contribution amount needed of \$14,625, 8.3%, needed each month to meet the budget). The contributions for May came to \$19,575 in donations, making the year to date giving \$65,063. That is 37% of the needed 41.5% at this time.
