



BULK TRASH PLACEMENT

If you have curbside collection, crews will only pick up piles placed close to the edge of the property. Crews can only reach up to 5 feet onto your property. Do not place piles near fixed objects.



Do not place piles on top of water meters.

If you have alley collection, place pile along your side of the alley wall. Avoid touching wall and blocking alley access.



Property owners are responsible for maintaining their portion of the alley.

IMPORTANT SERVICE DATES

Note these changes:

Service is not provided on the following dates.

Every collection day moves one day later.

- New Year's Day (Jan 1, 2024)
- Thanksgiving Day (Nov. 28, 2024)
- Christmas Day (Dec 25, 2024)
- * Thanksgiving Day is on a Thursday, therefore, collection will occur on Friday. Friday will occur on Saturday.

Regular pickup:

The city works a regular collection schedule on:

- Christmas Eve
- New Year's Eve
- Juneteenth
- Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- Presidents' Day
- Cesar Chavez Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Veterans Day
- Indigenous Peoples' Day

DO:

- ✓ Follow the dates for bulk trash placement.
- ✓ Sweep or rake area after collection, if necessary.
- √ Securely bag or box all grass, leaves, weeds, twigs and hedge clippings before placing out for bulk trash.
- Cut tree trimmings down to less than 12" in diameter and 4' in length.
- ✓ Place broken down cardboard in your recycle container.

DON'T INCLUDE:

- More than 20 cubic yards in your pile, which is similar to the size of a SUV.
- More than 25 pounds of construction and/or demolition waste.
- Household hazardous waste (HHW), such as antifreeze, pool chemicals, oil, batteries and paint.
- Tires, any shape or size.
- Appliances that use refrigerants.




How to Find a Lost Dog?






Don't Kill House Centipedes

Recipe of the Month April Fool's Meatloaf Cake

INGREDIENTS:

2 lbs lean ground beef

3 large eggs

1 cup breadcrumbs

2/3 cup sliced green onion

1/2 cup milk

1/2 cup chopped fresh parsley

3 large garlic cloves, minced

2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce

1 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

1 (12 ounce) jar roasted red peppers, drained and patted dry

3 1/2 cups hot mashed potatoes

8 cherry tomatoes, stems removed





DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 375°F In a large bowl, combine ground beef, eggs, bread crumbs, green onions, milk, parsley, garlic, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper just until blended.

Divide mixture between two 8-inch round cake pans, patting to cover pans evenly and make level.

Bake meat loaves until juices run clear when meat is pierced with a fork, or meat loaves register 170F on a meat thermometer, 20-25 minutes. Remove pans from the oven; cover loosely with foil and let stand for 10 minutes.

Pour off juices from pans. Invert 1 meat loaf onto a flat serving plate. Using a small sharp knife, trim red peppers so that they lie flat. Cover top of meat loaf with a single layer of roasted red peppers.

Invert second meat loaf onto red pepper layer. Using a spatula, spread 2 1/2 cups mashed potatoes over top and sides of meat loaf. Spoon remaining potatoes into a pastry bag fitted with a large star tip. Pipe swirls around top edges of cake. Pipe stars around bottom of cake.

Place cherry tomatoes, stem-ends down, in a ring around top of meat loaf "cake" to resemble cherries. Cut meat loaf into wedges; serve immediately.
