

# Roundabouts

## Turn Right taking the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit

As you passed the junction before your Exit, check centre and left mirrors and Indicate left.

Enter roundabout if it is safe and go around indicating right. Keep your speed reasonable to avoid getting too close or brushing to centre of the roundabout.  
Avoid changing gears inside small roundabouts to have full control on your steering wheel.

**Look:** look in to roundabout and check for priorities and a safe gap to go. Early observation leads to an early and better decision. Use **LADA**.

**Speed:** gently slow down and change to 2<sup>nd</sup> gear, cover your clutch and be ready to stop if you need to.  
*"Plan to stop, but look to go"*

**Position:** position your car close to centre line.

**Signal:** If it is safe signal Right in a good time. Higher the speed you are traveling, indicate earlier and give enough time to traffic react.  
(30 mph speed = 6 or 8 length of car)  
(60 mph speed + 300 yards)

**Mirrors:** check centre and Right mirrors to see what is happening behind and look for any overtaking vehicles

Give way to traffic approaching from the right and vehicles are already inside roundabout. Check other vehicles' signal, position and speed to make a better decision.
