Contest Theme: "In a World Where You Can Be Anything, Be Kind"

Some examples: What does kindness look like to you? Can you think of a time when someone showed you kindness? Who was it? Where were you?
Is there someone you can be kind to?
What is a way you can show someone kindness?

Guidelines For Artwork:

- Eligibility: All students K5-6th Grade
- All media is allowed.
- Writing is not allowed on the front of the artwork. Encourage students to tell us their story through art.
- All artwork is to be completed while the child is at school

Entry Guidelines:

- Each entry must include on the back upper right hand corner: **Name, grade, teacher, and school**

Judging:

- Like last year, we are asking all schools NOT to hang/display the artwork. Instead, we will be picking up the artwork and returning it after it has been judged. **No judging will take place at the school.**
- Please have all artwork grouped together by grade and ready to be picked up from your school's office by the deadline below.

Contest entries will be picked up: Week of March 4-8, 2024
