THE CONFINED ARTS (TCA) IS A PROGRAM, LOCATED AT COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY AND MT. ZION THAT CULTIVATES AND SHOWCASES THE TALENTS AND CREATIVE VOICES OF ARTISTS DIRECTLY IMPACTED BY MASS INCARCERATION AND INTERSECTING SOCIAL JUSTICE ISSUES. TCA ENABLES ARTISTS TO EXPRESS THEIR VOICES THROUGH THE VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS, POETRY, AND MUSIC AS A MEANS TO ABOLISH INHUMANE NARRATIVES AND SOCIALLY DEGRADING STIGMAS THAT ARE USED TO DESCRIBE THE PAST EXPERIENCES AND LIMIT THE FUTURES OF INDIVIDUALS IMPACTED BY INCARCERATION. THROUGH ARTISTRY, COLLABORATIVE ACTIVISM, RESEARCH, EDUCATION AND TRAINING, TCA EQUIPS ARTISTS TO INFLUENCE POLICY CHANGE, AND USE THEIR ARTISTRY AND KNOWLEDGE TO ADVOCATE FOR A WORLD ANCHORED ON EMPATHY AND SATURATED WITH HEALING AND PREVENTION-BASED POLICIES.



IN 2020 THE CONFINED ARTS PARTNERED WITH THE CENTER FOR COURT INNOVATION AND CONSPIRING FOR GOOD TO MAP, GALVANIZE AND SUPPORT ARTISTS, ARTS ORGANIZATIONS, PROJECTS, AND PROGRAMS FOCUSED ON RACIAL JUSTICE, RESTORATIVE JUSTICE, TRANSFORMATIVE JUSTICE, AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORM BY FORMING THE ARTS JUSTICE SAFETY COALITION. THIS COALITION IS MADE UP OF ARTS PROGRAMS AND PRACTITIONERS WORKING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE CRIMINAL LEGAL SYSTEM AND INTEGRATING SAFETY, ACCOUNTABILITY AND JUSTICE INTO THEIR WORK.

RITUAL 4 RETURN

RITUAL4RETURN (R4R) IS A 12-WEEK PROGRAM THAT GUIDES FORMERLY INCARCERATED MEN AND WOMEN THROUGH THE PROCESS OF CREATING AND PERFORMING A RITE OF PASSAGE. THE PROCESS HELPS PARTICIPANTS AS THEY TRANSITION FROM INCARCERATION TO FREEDOM. IT IS A DEMANDING JOURNEY. IT PUSHES PEOPLE INTELLECTUALLY, PHYSICALLY, EMOTIONALLY, AND SPIRITUALLY AS THEY DEFINE AND THEN CROSS THE THRESHOLDS THAT MARK THE TRANSITION FROM OLD PATTERNS, BEHAVIORS, AND IDENTITIES INTO THE NEW LIFE THEY SEEK TO MANIFEST.

THIS PROGRAM IS FOR ANYONE WHO HAS EVER BEEN INCARCERATED. IT DOESN'T MATTER HOW LONG YOU WERE IN OR HOW LONG YOU'VE BEEN OUT. R4R IS A HEALING AND TRANSFORMATIVE TOOL FOR ANYONE WHO SEEKS TO MOVE ON FROM THEIR EXPERIENCES OF PRISON AND INTO A NEW LIFE.

RITES OF PASSAGE: WHAT AND WHY

RITUALS ARE REPEATED PRACTICES THAT HELP GIVE OUR LIFE MEANING. A RITE OF PASSAGE IS A SPECIFIC TYPE OF RITUAL MEANT TO FACILITATE A PERSON'S TRANSITION FROM ONE SOCIAL AND SPIRITUAL IDENTITY TO ANOTHER. THESE TRANSITIONS CAN GO UP OR DOWN. WHEN A PERSON IS CONVICTED OF A CRIME AND SENTENCED TO PRISON, THEY UNDERGO A POWERFUL RITE OF PASSAGE. IT IS A RITE OF DEGRADATION. THEY ARE DEGRADED FROM THE STATUS OF "CITIZEN" TO THE STATUS OF "CONVICT," "PRISONER" OR "OUTCAST."

BUT WORDS LIKE CONVICT AND PRISONER ARE MORE THAN JUST LEGAL LABELS. THEY BECOME NEW SOCIAL IDENTITIES. THEY STICK TO A PERSON. THE BROADER PUBLIC DEFINES PEOPLE BY THE CRIMES THEY'VE COMMITTED, AND FORMERLY INCARCERATED MEN AND WOMEN CAN CARRY FEELINGS OF SHAME AND STIGMA FOR MANY YEARS AFTER THEY ARE RELEASED FROM PRISON. OFTEN THESE FEELINGS LAST THE REST OF THEIR LIVES...

FOOD BANK FOR NEW YORK CITY

FOOD BANK FOR NEW YORK CITY HAS BEEN WORKING TO END FOOD POVERTY IN OUR FIVE BOROUGHS SINCE 1983. AS THE CITY'S LARGEST HUNGER-RELIEF ORGANIZATION, WE EMPLOY A MULTIFACETED APPROACH CENTERED ON HELPING LOW-INCOME NEW YORKERS OVERCOME THEIR CIRCUMSTANCES AND ACHIEVE GREATER INDEPENDENCE.

REENTRY THEATER OF HARLEM

REENTRY THEATER OF HARLEM (RTH) IS AN INDEPENDENT NONPROFIT PROGRAM, DEVELOPED WITH, BY AND FOR PEOPLE WHO HAVE LIVED EXPERIENCE IN THE U.S. CRIMINAL LEGAL SYSTEM. OUR MISSION IS TO EMPOWER AND SUPPORT PEOPLE IN SAFE AND CREATIVE SPACES AS THEY MAKE THE DIFFICULT TRANSITION FROM PRISON BACK TO SOCIETY AND BECOME POSITIVE CONTRIBUTORS TO THEIR FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES.

RTH UTILIZES ART, RITUALS, AND THEATRICAL RITES OF PASSAGE TO HELP INDIVIDUALS ADDRESS AND OVERCOME THE SHAME, STIGMA, AND TRAUMA OF INCARCERATION. ULTIMATELY, PARTICIPANTS DEVISE AND ENACT A THRESHOLD CROSSING TO FORMALLY MARK THE TRANSITION FROM PRISON BACK INTO THEIR COMMUNITIES AND INTO A NEW STAGE OF LIFE.

ALEX ANDERSON IS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF RTH. ALEX, A SURVIVOR OF MASS INCARCERATION, SPENT A TOTAL OF 15 YEARS IN NYS PRISONS. WHILE IN PRISON, ALEX EARNED A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA AND, BEFORE COLLEGE IN PRISON PROGRAMS WERE DECIMATED, A BA FROM SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY. AFTER HIS RELEASE, ALEX WORKED TO MAKE AMENDS AND IMPROVE HIS COMMUNITY. HIS CAREER AS A SOCIAL WORKER HAS SPANNED MORE THAN TWO DECADES AND WAS FUELED BY A MSW FROM SILBERMAN SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK, A NEW YORK STATE CERTIFICATE IN ADDICTION COUNSELING, AND A RESTORATIVE JUSTICE CERTIFICATE FROM THE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF RESTORATIVE JUSTICE. IN 2009, ALEX PERFORMED HIS RITE OF PASSAGE AT JOHN JAY COLLEGE.

RTH IS A BOLD AND IMAGINATIVE APPROACH FOR CONFRONTING THE DEVASTATING IMPACT OF MASS INCARCERATION. GROUNDED IN CULTURAL AND ARTISTIC EXPRESSION AND DRAWING ON DECADES OF CRIMINOLOGICAL LITERATURE, RTH IS DEEPLY RESTORATIVE FOR INDIVIDUALS AND COMMUNITIES. IT IS DESIGNED TO DEVELOP LEADERSHIP AMONG THE PEOPLE WHO ARE MOST IMPACTED BY MASS INCARCERATION IN WAYS THAT ALLOW THE MODEL TO MULTIPLY AND SCALE.

FOOD BANK FOR NEW YORK CITY

MISSION IS TO HELP MOBILIZE OUR COMMUNITIES TO BREAK DOWN BARRIERS AND BUILD OPPORTUNITIES THAT IMPROVE THE LIVES OF LOW-INCOME NEW YORKERS FOR THE BENEFIT OF ALL.

EMMAUS HOUSE OF HARLEM

EMMAUS HOUSE IS A SUPPORTIVE, HEALING, INCLUSIVE, FAITH-BASED COMMUNITY FOR PEOPLE IN TRANSITION WHO EMPOWER THEMSELVES (AND OTHERS) TO BUILD A SOCIETY OF COMPASSION, OPPORTUNITY, EQUITY, AND JUSTICE. COLLECTIVELY WE NURTURE, HEAL, BUILD RESILIENCE, AND LIFT ONE ANOTHER UP TO OUR HIGHEST POTENTIAL. THROUGH RELATIONSHIPS, WE EDUCATE AND MOBILIZE THE LARGER COMMUNITY TO ADDRESS ISSUES OF POVERTY AND INJUSTICE WHILE WORKING TOGETHER FOR PEACE AND SOCIAL CHANGE. WE STRIVE TO HEAL OURSELVES, OUR COMMUNITY, AND THE WORLD.

CENTRAL SYNAGOUGE

CENTRAL SYNAGOGUE WORKS TOWARD A WORLD IN WHICH JUDAISM IS CENTRAL TO OUR LIVES AND IS A PROFOUND AND POSITIVE FORCE FOR HUMANITY. WE ARE CONSTANTLY EVOLVING AS WE PURSUE THAT GOAL. TOGETHER, WE LEARN, WORSHIP, SERVE, AND CONTINUALLY REDEFINE WHAT IT MEANS TO BE JEWISH TODAY, BOTH WITHIN OUR COMMUNITY AND FAR BEYOND OUR WALLS.

IN DECEMBER 2020, WE WERE THRILLED TO ANNOUNCE A NEW PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN CENTRAL SYNAGOGUE AND THE MULTIFAITH INITIATIVE TO END MASS INCARCERATION (EMI), THE MULTIFAITH INITIATIVE TO END MASS INCARCERATION LEVERAGES THE POWERS OF U.S. FAITH LEADERS AND COMMUNITIES TO EMPHATICALLY DEMAND AND ACT TO END MASS INCARCERATION.

STELLA ADLER STUDIO OF ACTING

THE STELLA ADLER STUDIO UPHOLDS A UNIQUE FOCUS IN AMERICAN ACTOR TRAINING. LIKE JACOB, STELLA AND HAROLD, THE STUDIO AFFIRMS THAT THE PRIMARY FUNCTION OF THEATER IS TO UPLIFT HUMANITY. A SUCCESSFUL STUDENT FOR STELLA IS NOT NECESSARILY ONE WHO BECOMES FAMOUS OR RICH, BUT ONE WHO CONNECTS TO THEIR DEEPER SELF AND TO OUR SHARED HUMANITY. THE SCHOOL IS A CULTURAL CENTER DETERMINED TO TRAIN ACTORS AND SUPPORT ARTISTS NOT DESPITE, BUT IN THE FACE OF A WORLD IN CRISIS. PROGRAMS LIKE THE OUTREACH DIVISION HELP TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS TO BECOME ACTORS LIKE STELLA AND THOSE IN THE GROUP THEATER: ACTORS WHO ARE SOCIALLY AND CONSCIOUSLY AWARE AND WHOSE AWARENESS CONTRIBUTES TO THEIR ABILITY TO ACT PASSIONATELY.


