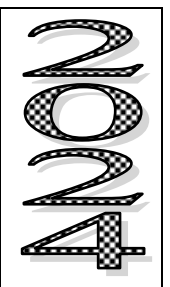

It seems like everything is coming early this year. First, Lent came early. It began the second Wednesday of February and now it is halfway done. Lent came early this year because Easter comes early this year on March 31. The entirety of the Lenten season including Holy Week and Easter will occur and be done by the time April arrives.

I hope this year we will not wait until the spring to kick the church into high gear, but, instead, will come out early to worship, fellowship, study, and pray with each other.

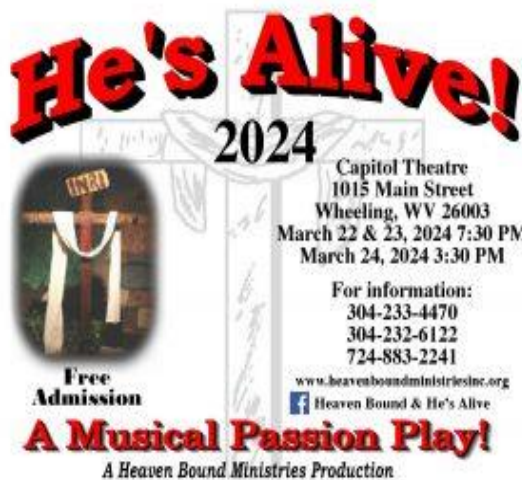

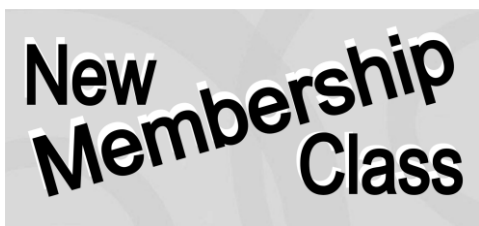
