#### **Lathe Safety Check**

Do Not Turn if Tired, Upset, Sick or Tipsy

Use Safety Glasses & Face Mask

Wear Short Sleeves, No Jewelry, Comfortable Shoes, Tie-up Hair

**Sharpen Tools** 

Remove Shavings and Clutter, Eliminate Distractions

Is Blank Sound and Securely Mounted? (both ends)

Check Locks on Tool Rest, Banjo, Tailstock, etc.

Rotate Work by Hand First

Begin at Low Speed, Listen while Turning

Turn Lathe Off for Adjustments

Remove Tool Rest and Use Dust Mask while Sanding
