- *Food technology*- linked to our studies of South America, children will plan, prep and cook a traditional South American recipe

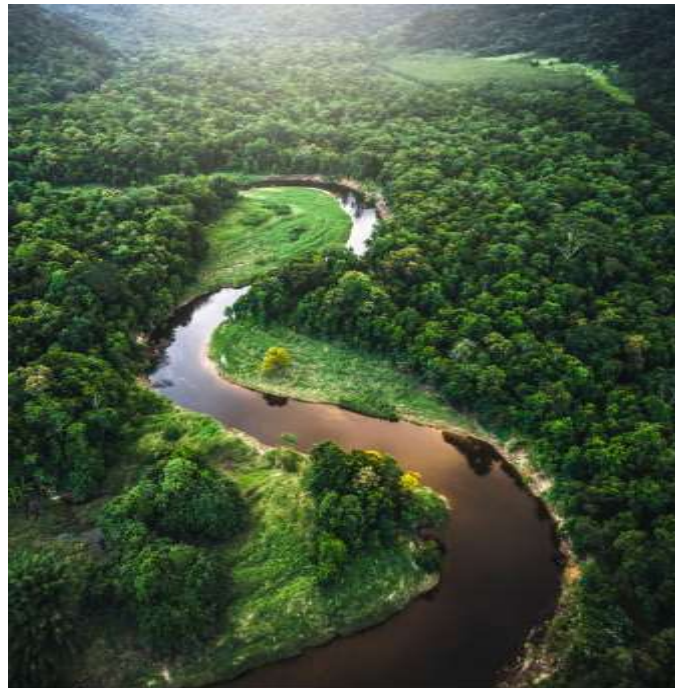
COME AND SEE:
