Entries:

- One entry per horse/rider combination per show. Mail or email entry and payment to the Secretary at address given below.
- Online entries may be paid online by venmo to @Miriam-Offermanns, or an entry form printed out and mailed with a check (made out to MILYM Equestrian) for full fees to secretary. If paying by venmo, please email proof of payment to maryloufreil@gmail.com
- Regardless of method of payment, a signed GDCTA hold harmless and current coggins must be mailed, or emailed to:

- Entries must be in the secretaries hand before closing date. Entries may be accepted after closing date if space permits and late fee paid.

Arenas: Introductory classes and USEA tests will be ridden in a small arena (20x40). Training Level and above will be ridden in a large arena (20x60).

Footing: Competition arena footing is M-10. **Warm-up will be on a level grass field.**

Stabling: Limited stabling available. Stall includes one wheel barrow load of shavings. Please strip your stall before you leave. Call or text Miriam at 828-506-6876 before you come so she can have your stall ready.

Dress: Formal attire encouraged but not mandatory. Polo shirts acceptable. No tee shirts. Half chaps are permitted. ASTM/SEI helmets mandatory when mounted and appropriate footwear required.

Awards:

- Ribbons awarded through 6th place. Classes will be split into Junior and Adult divisions if entries warrant.
- High Point awards will be awarded to the horse/rider with the highest and second highest score in Dressage.
- Lisa Seger Insurance Medal will be awarded to the highest placed Adult Amateur GDCTA member in Training Level Test 3. Winner will be eligible for the Final to be held at the GDCTA Schooling Show in August

Refunds: Scratches prior to or on closing date: all fees except office fee will be refunded. Scratches after closing date: credit for all fees less office fee for a future show will be given with vet or doctor's excuse. Credit must be used within 1 year of scratched show. Inclement weather is not a valid excuse for scratching.

Substitutions: Substitution of horse or rider before or after the closing date will require a new entry form with a new office fee. Class fees will be transferred to the new entry.

Confirmation/Times: Confirmation of entry will be by email. All email addresses must be clearly printed on entry form. Ride times will be posted on website (www.bellaroseeq.com) and emailed to competitors Thursday before the show. It is the responsibility of the competitor to notify management of any ride conflicts as soon as possible after times have been published.

Non-Compete Horse: Non-compete horses are welcome as space permits. A complete entry is required along with coggins, signatures and office fee, stabling fee, and non-compete horse fee paid.

Special Classes: If there is a class you would like to compete in and you don't see it here, just ask. We'll do our best to accommodate you.

Management reserves the right to refuse or limit entries, to add or divide classes, to add or substitute judges or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition herein for the improvement of the competition. Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis before the closing date or until show is filled.

GDCTA Hold Harmless Clause

The undersigned competitor/rider and all signors below hereby (1) agrees to release the management of this show or clinic, their officers, directors, employees, members, or agents, and the owners or managers of the grounds where this event is held, from any loss, damage, liability, or injury arising out of or resulting from this show or clinic or competitors/riders participation therein; (2) agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Georgia Dressage and Combined Training Association, Inc., the organizer, facility owner, and the management of this show or clinic from and against any and all claims for loss, damage, liability, or injury, however caused, resulting directly or indirectly from competitors/riders entry or participation in this show or clinic or from acts or omissions of competitor/rider or competitor's agents; and (3) acknowledges that activities with and around horses and horse shows or clinics involve inherent risks including but not limited to substantial risk of bodily injury, death, property damage and other dangers including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death resulting from kicks and bites, falling off horse or horse(s) falling on Rider, being dragged by a foot caught in the stirrups, Rider being thrown by horse, equipment failure or collision with horse(s) or vehicles or other inanimate objects, as well as any and all risks of contracting Covid-19. In the event of injury to competitor/rider or to competitor's/rider's animals, permission is hereby granted to management for emergency medical treatment.

Every entry at a Georgia Dressage and Combined Training Association, Inc. (GDCTA) recognized competition or clinic shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, handler, the horse, volunteers and staff), for themselves, their principals, representatives, employees, and agents: (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the GDCTA and the local rules of the competition or clinic; (2) represent that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) agree to be bound by the constitution and rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and of the competition or clinic, and will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition or clinic, the GDCTA, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize the GDCTA and the competition or clinic management to market, transfer, assign, or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to, or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the event, sport, or the GDCTA, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation; and (5) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition or clinic fully aware that horse sports and the competition or clinic involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to indemnify and hold harmless the GDCTA, the competition or clinic, and the officials, directors, employees, and agents from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition or clinic, whether or not such claim, injury, or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of the GDCTA, competition or clinic. The construction and application of USEF Rules are governed by laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against USEF must be filed in New York State, see Article 1502.5.

Clinic Equine Activity Release and Hold Harmless Agreement

1. I, _____, the undersigned have read and understand, and freely and voluntarily enter into this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with Milym Equestrian LLC (dba BellaRose Equestrian) and Miriam Offermanns and the Family and Employees of The Offermanns, understanding that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is a waiver of any and all liability(ies).
2. I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, walking, boarding, feeding said horse; including, but not limited to any interactions with other horses. Understanding those risks I hereby release Milym Equestrian LLC (dba BellaRose Equestrian) and Miriam Offermanns and the Family and Employees of The Offermanns, its officers, directors, shareholders, employees and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with from any liability whatsoever in the event of injury or damage of any nature (or perhaps even death) to me or anyone else caused by or incidental to my electing to mount and ride said horse(s).
3. I understand and recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement, is being voluntarily and intentionally signed and agreed to, and that in signing this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement I know and understand that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement may further limit the liability of equine professionals to include any activity, whatsoever, involving an equine, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property.
4. I recognize and agree that I know which equine professional(s) I will be working with, and acknowledge that I agree said equine professional(s) has/have made reasonable and prudent efforts to determine my ability to engage in the equine activity, and has/have sufficient knowledge of my equine and horseback riding skills as to relieve, release and hold harmless said equine professional(s) from any continuing duty to monitor my equine activities.
5. I further voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless this (these) equine professional(s) from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professionals negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting; riding; dismounting; walking; grooming; feeding; use of horse barn, paddock, trails or horse ring or at competitions, in any capacity; falling off horse whether horse is bucking, rearing, flipping, spooked; or my failure to understand any equine professional's directions relating to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or the horse I have been assigned to.
6. I hereby (1) agree to release the management of this clinic/show/event, their officers, directors, employees, members, or agents, and the owners or managers of the grounds where this event is held, from any loss, damage, liability, or injury arising out of or resulting from this clinic or riders participation therein; (2) agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend Milym Equestrian LLC, the organizer, facility owner, and the management of this clinic/show/event from and against any and all claims for loss, damage, liability, or injury, however caused, resulting directly or indirectly from riders entry or participation in this clinic or from acts or omissions of rider or rider's agents; and (3) acknowledge that activities with and around horses and horse clinics involve inherent risks including but not limited to substantial risk of bodily injury, death, property damage and other dangers including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death resulting from kicks and bites, falling off horse or horse(s) falling on Rider, being dragged by a foot caught in the stirrups, Rider being thrown by horse, equipment failure or collision with horse(s) or vehicles or other inanimate objects, as well as any and all risks of contracting Covid-19. In the event of injury to rider or to rider's animals, permission is hereby granted to management for emergency medical treatment.
7. By signing this agreement I hereby authorize Milym Equestrian LLC at BellaRose Equestrian to market, transfer, assign, or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to, or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the event, sport, or the farm, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.
8. I understand and agree that my participation is voluntarily in the clinic/show/event/XC-schooling and I am fully aware that horse sports especially cross country jumping can pose serious risks including but not limited to inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death. I understand that all cross country obstacles at event site do not use frangible pin technology. I understand and agree that I am voluntarily participating and jumping the cross country fences at will and will not hold Milym Equestrian LLC liable for any injury or loss, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Milym Equestrian LLC, the clinic, and the officials, directors, employees, and agents from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the clinic, whether or not such claim, injury, or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of Milym Equestrian LLC, or clinic.
