RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The 54th NJ State USBC Youth Championship Scholarship Tournament will be governed by the tournament rules as prescribed by the USBC and the Board of Directors of the NJ State USBC Youth Association.
- Membership must be through a local NJ USBC Youth Association or Affiliation for the current season.
- USBC Youth Certification card must be presented at the time of check in by the youth bowler. Youth bowlers not in possession of a USBC membership card must purchase a card at the tournament site prior to the start of bowling and meet the average requirement as stated below.
- All Entry forms must be filled out completely with all necessary Youth League verifications. Incomplete entries will not be accepted or processed. Proper entry fee must
 accompany each entry form in the form of a check or money order and made payable to the NJ STATE USBC YA. There is a \$40.00 returned check fee.
- ENTRY FEE is \$25.00 per bowler per event Optional All Events Fee is \$5.00 (Scratch division)
- Entries will be scheduled based on squad availability. Confirmations will be sent to the **Team Captain** will be contacted if a requested squad date or time is not available and will be given the dates and times that are available to bowl. All entries will be processed on a first come first serve basis for squad dates and times. Once your squad is assigned by the Tournament Director, 48 hours notice must be given to change squads and these changes will be made upon lane availability.
- ENTRIES ARE DUE to the Tournament Director by March 24, 2018. All Entries that are received after this date by the Tournament Director will be scheduled in accordance to lane availability per squad.
- NO WALK-IN ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- Multiple entries are permitted for the TEAM event only. In order to place in the award standings at least two players must be different.
 Your application for a multiple entry must be received by the entry deadline March 24, 2018.
- Average Rule to be used in this order
 - 1. Bowler will use highest average from the 2016-2017 winter season based on a minimum of 12 games.
 - 2. Bowler will use highest summer 2017 season average based on a minimum of 12 games.
 - 3. Bowler does not have an average from the 2016-2017 winter or summer season, they will use highest league average for 12 games or more as of December 31, 2017
 - 4. Bowlers not having an average shall use 220.

Please provide average verification for a summer or current average. All entering averages must have been compiled in a New Jersey State Certified League only.

- Substitutions must be reported to the Tournament Director prior to the start of the scheduled squad. The Tournament Director reserves the right to accept or deny any proposed substitute. Proper Tournament USBC certification and average verification must accompany the substitute.
- Tournament play 3 games will be bowled for each event. Late bowlers will not receive any practice and will receive zero pin fall for all frames not bowled.
- Dress Code: Bowlers are expected to wear acceptable attire. Please use good judgment when picking out your attire.

Examples of ACCEPTABLE attire:

- Collared shirts, mock-turtle neck shirts, dye sublimated shirts and USBC Youth Jersey.
- Dress slacks, jeans and skirts in good condition.
- Shorts, skirts and skorts with a finished bottom (NO FRAYED HEMLINES). Length of shorts, skirts or skorts must be below the competitor fingertips
 when they are standing and their arms are hanging down at their side.

Examples of UNACCEPTABLE attire include but are not limited to:

- Head gear (permitted for medical reasons only).
- T-shirts, halter tops, bare midriff, and spaghetti strap tops etc.
- Workout attire, basketball shorts, short shorts, short shirts, bibbed overalls, and jeans that are not neat, clean or in good condition (NO TORN JEANS).
- At no time can a bowler's undergarments be showing
- Attire depicting alcohol, tobacco or gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures man not be worn in accordance with Rule 301B.
- Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee will be final.
- Scholarship money earned will be processed through the USBC SMART program. Scholarship money shall be returned 100%. The award ratio shall be 1 out of 6 entries in each event/division.
- The Tournament Director and Committee reserves all rights. Any of all appeals and protest will fall under the procedures outline in USBC Rule # 329.
- Should inclement weather become a factor please check the facebook page New Jersey State Youth Bowling Association or call Woodbridge Bowling Center at 732-634-4520
 to see if tournament play has been cancelled. Squads postponed due to inclement weather will be made up on a date to be determined. Please contact the Tournament
 Director to verify these date and time for the postponed squads.
- Additional sauad times for singles, doubles, and team events may be added if the Tournament Director deems it necessary for any extenuating circumstances.

- 1. Please fill in entry form completely. No line up changes will be made at the tournament site (except in the case of a substitute).
- 2. Please indicate preferred 1st and 2nd choice dates and squad times for each event.
- 3. Record bowler names as they appear on their USBC membership card.
- 4. Average verifications are required for bowlers without 2016-2017 final winter average of at least 12 games.

 All submitted averages must be verified by March 24, 2018. Bowlers with unverified averages will compete using a 220 scratch average.
- 5. ALL FEES DUE MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY FORM.
- 6. DO NOT SEND CASH! Payment may be made by personal check, cashier's check or money order.

 There will be a \$40.00 fee charge for all returned checks. Any outstanding fees must be paid prior to bowling any event(s).
- 7. Teams wishing to be paired together must indicate so in writing and include all entries in the same envelope. Every effort will be made to accommodate such requests.
