#### 1. PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY

- A. Tournament is limited to 80 entries
- B. Only adult members of the CJMCUSBC are eligible to compete in this tournament
  - l) Current adult USBC certified non-members may enter by paying the local certification fee (\$10.00) on site
- C. Winners of a National PBA Title over the last Calendar Year are ineligible
- D. If you wish to be paired with specific individuals, please send entry forms in together and we will do our best to accommodate. Please note walkins will be given lane assignments to best suit the flow of the tournament

#### 2. LANE CONDITIONS

A. Lane Conditions will be pre-determined by the Tournament Committee

#### 3. HANDICAP

- A. This is a HANDICAP event
  - 1) Handicap will be 100% of 240
  - 2) Any bowler entering with an average greater than 240 will receive no handicap

#### 4. ENTERING AVERAGES

- A. Highest CJMCUSBC average for a minimum of 21 games for the 2016-2017 winter season
- B. Highest USBC average for a minimum of 21 games for the 2016-2017 winter season
- C. Highest CJMCUSBC average for a minimum of 21 games for the 2015-2016 winter season
- D. Highest USBC average for a minimum of 21 games for the 2015-2016 winter season
- E. Highest CJMCUSBC average for a minimum of 21 games as of January 1, 2018
  - ) League Standing sheet verifying avera<mark>ge as of</mark> January 1, 2018, must be provided, along with signature from league secretary
- F. Highest USBC average for a minimum of 21 games as of January 1, 2018
  - 1) League Standing sheet verifying average as of January 1, 2018, must be provided, along with signature from league secretary
- G. If no average meeting the above criteria exists, entrant will be assigned a 240 average and receive no handicap

#### 7. QUALIFYING ROUND

- A. There will be one (1) qualifying squad consisting of 4 games across 8 lanes
- B. Maximum of 8 bowlers per pair
- C. Bowlers must check-in at least 45 minutes prior to start of the qualifying squad
- D. Walk-ins will be accepted as long as spots remain available
  - 1) Entries close 15 minutes prior to start of the qualifying squad
- E. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero score for all frames missed
- F. Two re-racks permitted per game, additional re-racks must be approved by a tournament official
- G. Total 4-game pin-fall at the completion of the qualifying round will determine qualifying standings

#### 8. CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND

- A. The top 5 qualifying bowlers will advance to a 1-game stepladder final with 39 entries or less
- B. The top 8 qualifying bowlers will advance to an 8-player single –game elimination bracket final with 40 entries or more
- C.  $\,\,$  If a tie occurs for any qualifying spot, a one (1) game roll-off will be conducted prior to the start of the finals
  - 1) If the score remains tied, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be conducted until a winner is determined
- D. The Tournament committee will assign lanes according to seeded position based on total pin-fall from the qualifying round
- E. Lanes will be re-oiled with the finalist receiving 5 minutes of practice before the first round, and 2 shots per lane in each subsequent round
- F. If a tie occurs during the Championship Round, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be conducted until a winner is determined

#### 9. PRIZES

- A. At least one out of every five (5) entries will receive prize money
- B. Prize Fund returned 100%
