

## AXE THROWING SAFETY RULES

The Battle Axes facility, its directors and staff accept no liability for any damagesor losses suffered as a result of any activities in, on or around the Batting Cages, the Archery Lanes or the Axe Throwing Lanes. The Battle Axes is not responsible for lost or damaged personal equipment or property.

- 1. All Axe Lane participants must wear closed toe shoes. If you don't have closed toe shoes, some can be provided.
- 2. If there are throwers in both throwing boxes in a bay, throwers may throw at the same time or take turns, but the axes can only be retrieved after both throwers have thrown their axe.
- 3. Only one axe thrower in the throwing box at a time, all others must be in the axe pit.
- 4. Axes are NOT allowed outside the lanes, except at the start and completion of the game.
- 5. Do not hand the axe to the next thrower. Place the axe in the box after retrieval.
- 6. Throwers may use a single-hand throw or a two-hand throw.
- 7. No "trick shots" allowed.
- 8. For a firmly thrown axe, when retrieving from the target, do not put your hand on the target to pull the axe from the target. First, push the bottom of the handle toward the face of the target, and then wiggle up and down to remove the axe.
- 9. Scoring a throw when the axe is primarily in one point value, but the axe blade has actually broken the edge of the line of the next point value, the score is the next higher point value. This may even require removing the axe to determine where the blade has left it's "cut".
- 10. Bounce outs are scored as a miss.
- 11. In a tic-tac-toe game, if the thrower breaks the line of the square they were going for, the score will be awarded to the thrower.
- 12. In a tic-tac-toe game, if the thrower hits a square already scored by the other participant, then the throw is a "miss".
