Call to Order

Old Business

Items From Meeting with City of TorC Management

- A meeting was held with the city on 04/15/2022. Notes from this meeting appear after the April minutes on the website.
- **Range Gate Closing:**
 - The city attorney has indicated that he will draft a liability waiver for Rio Vaqueros Inc. members with regard to closing the range gates at night.
 - The city has indicated that dispatch will send police officers immediately if a need arises.
 - We will need to form a work party to fix the fence before a nightly gate closing can actually prevent after hours range entry.
 - The city is not in a big hurry and realistically we would start doing this in the fall if we can come up with enough volunteers and settle on an acceptable schedule.
 - Jim Paxon requested that the secretary, Carol W, write up a thank you letter to the city to be signed by Carl Mc. for the city's recent efforts at range cleanup. (Pending from April meeting)
- **Friends of the Range:** The city has indicated that they are in favor of setting up a friends of the range organization to accept donations for range maintenance and improvements.
 - This would require its own Non-profit entity and management body.
 - This effort is in its infancy and further talks and coordination with the city will be forthcoming.

- Carol W has agreed to develop a digital logo prototype based on the discussions from the previous meeting before June 5.

NRA Women On Target Event
