Call to Order

- George Tobin donated \$100 towards the diesel fund. The Rio Vaqueros are sending a check to the county for \$1497.96 to cover the cost of diesel for the range work.
- Carol Whitney and Jim Paxon will draft a letter of thanks to the county to accompany the check.
- Jim Paxon has built new concrete bench forms for two new rifle benches and Carl, Jim, and David poured the concrete. The concrete has been reinforced with rebar.
- A work party will need to be scheduled to install the benches.

New Business

Vandalism at Pistol Range Storage Lockers

- The locks on the storage lockers at the pistol pits were vandalized. Nothing was taken. George Tobin was able to fix them but we have realized that we have no spare locks.
- Carol Whitney made a motion to authorize George Tobin to obtain and key 3 spare locks. Seconded by Jim Anton. Motion carried.
