How To Be Prepared For Your Classes

- Know your class schedule. Which days do you have classes? What time do they start? Write them down and put them in your calendar. So many times, we have parents who just simply forget.
- Do you have all the correct dance clothes, clean and ready to wear? Most of us don't have a stockpile of leotards and tights laying around, so being prepared is key.
 - o We suggest having two sets of dance clothes on hand and ready to rotate.
 - o Create a space at home to store all things dance.
 - o Designate a dance bag with all items you will need.

- Who is bringing you to dance? Will you be coming straight from school? What car will you be in? Often students come straight from school and realize they do not have their dance stuff. One person drops them off at school and someone else picks them up.
 - o Prepare your dance bag with everything you need for dance.
 - o Think ahead to who is going to be picking you up from school and which car your dance bag needs to be in.
- Do you have the dance shoes you will need for class?
 - o Again, keeping a specific bag used for dance with all your clothes, shoes, etc. is the best way to always have what you need for class.

- How long will you be at dance? Do you need to bring a snack? Will you need dinner? Do you have your water bottle?
 - We suggest every student bring a water bottle to class with them. We do not supply cups for water at the studio, and we do not have a drinking fountain.
 - o Some students will be at dance for several hours, and we want to make sure they are well nourished. Have a plan for snacks and dinner if needed. A sack lunch/dinner works great.
 - o Students are welcome to eat between classes.

Do you know which room your class will be in?

- We have three rooms at WDC. Main Studio A, the first studio by the small parking lot right off the main road.
 Studio B, next to the main room, entrance off of the main parking lot along the fence. Studio D, the second to last door at the end of the main parking lot.
- Each class is designated a studio room. In your parent portal, in class assignment, it will tell you which studio you will be in.
