The General Meeting was brought to order at 9:05 am

President – Sandy handed out a spreadsheet of the 2024 budget. It will be discussed and approved by the board. She reported annual tax forms have been filed and the Audit of 2023 financial documents was completed.

Secretary – General meeting minutes will be recorded and sent to the April Newsletter.

Treasurer – bank balance is \$12,836.59

Programs – March class had 21 signed up, 2 on zoom. April's 3 Jacks zoom class on April 26th is free to all members and the class would be open to non-members. A charge for this *special class fee* of \$15. Pat will send an announcement out and Linda will promote it on Facebook. You must register to get the zoom info and prep sheets. May 7, Road trip class to O'Flannery's is \$20. There is an additional surface fee is \$15 for the porch leaner project. A carpool sign-up sheet was given to Susan Bradbury (Costa Mesa), Laurie Stewart (Orange) and Rose Melgoza (Anaheim). Contact them to get a ride. June and July each have 9 signed up for class.

Decorative Painting Month – Nothing new to report.

Fundraising- Rose had 4 bundles for our raffle drawing. Susan donated a beautiful planter with succulents for the raffle. A pitching quarters game is planned for the afternoon.

Membership- We currently have 55 members. Seven are new members this year. New 2024 directories were distributed in class. The rest will be distributed later. The membership form will be updated to include new dues cost (+\$5) and Zoom options.

SCRUMPTIOUS PEANUT BUTTER COOKIES

Shared by Rose Melgoza

1 Cup Brown Sugar ½ Cup Creamy Peanut Butter ½ Cup Softened Butter

1 egg 1 ¹/₄ Cup Flour ³/₄ tsp. Baking Soda

½ tsp. Baking Powder 1 C. Peanut Butter Chips Granulated Sugar

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In large bowl, beat brown sugar, peanut butter, butter and egg with mixer on medium speed until creamy. Stir in flour, baking soda, baking powder until thoroughly mixed. Then add the peanut butter chips until blended. Line the cookie sheet with parchment paper.

Use a large ice cream scoop for each cookie. Makes about 12-16 cookies. I always add a few chips to each doughball on the top. Dip tops of balls in granulated sugar. Place balls, sugared sides up about 3 inches apart on your cookie sheet. Don't flatten your balls!

Bake cookies 13.5 minutes @ 375 degrees. Should look light brown when they are ready. Pull the cookie sheet from the oven and let them cool for 10 minutes on the hot sheet.
