## THE LORD'S SUPPER - REMEMBRANCE

Moderator Dr. Barbara L. Cain, Presiding

Baptism and the Lord's Supper are the two simple ordinances which Jesus Christ appointed to be observed in His church. As baptism is a symbol of his burial and resurrection, so the Lord's Supper is commemorative of His death and sufferings. Although the ordinances are symbols, their observance involves faith, confession, self-examination, discernment, gratitude, dedication, fellowship and worship.

The Lord's Supper is a memorial meal to commemorate the death of Jesus. The elements of the meal represent the body and blood of Christ, a fitting and divinely-ordered memorial.

The object of the Lord's Supper is not communing with each other, but communing with Christ; not in remembrance of each other, but as Jesus said, "*in remembrance of me.*"

"For I received from the Lord the teaching that I passed on to you: that the Lord Jesus, on the night He was betrayed, took a piece of bread, gave thanks to God, brake it, and said, '*This is my body, which is for you. Do this in memory of me.*' In the same way, after the supper, He took the cup and said, '*This is God's new covenant, sealed with my blood. Whenever you drink it, do so in memory of me.*'

This means that every time you eat this bread and drink from this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes. (1 Corinthians 11:23 - 26)
