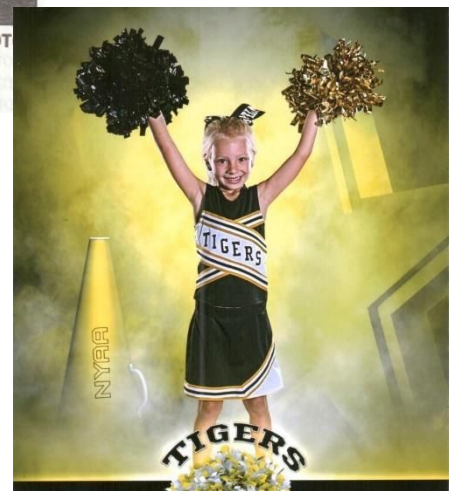

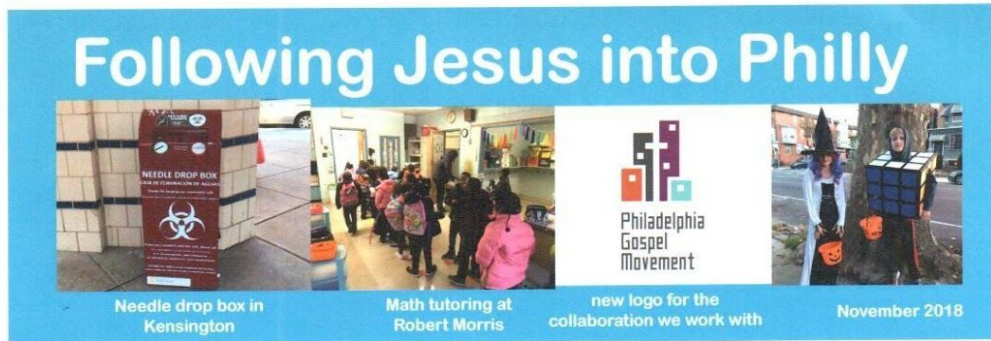

Leaving my comfort zone

This week, my (Katie) work with Cru City lead me into areas of brokenness in our city that I could not foresee doing even a couple years ago.

Tuesday I was distributing goods as a woman came into a safe place in Kensington, where just 20 minutes ago she overdosed on heroin, needing Narcan to save her life. At this location, exclusively for women, they can pick out clothing, socks and new underwear. Many of the women who come in are sex-workers, forced into this life through abusive relationships. At this location, we treat the women with dignity and respect and help to provide some basic needs that are often stolen from them. This woman knew of this safe place and was greeted by people that cared for her and showed her kindness.

Also, through Family Homework Night, we learned that math ability is also a great need at Robert Morris elementary. Monday was my first weekly math tutoring time with 1st and 3rd graders. I sat beside a 1st grader who was really struggling to get a fairly simple concept. Even with one-on-one attention, visuals, and much practice, she still wasn't getting the concept.

I know I'm not going to make a huge impact in Kensington or at Robert Morris, but I am staying

faithful and being obedient to where He leads, because God can change lives.

Philadelphia Gospel Movement

Just as our international student ministry saw greater effectiveness as organizations worked together, the same is happening as our work with Cru City is now part of the Philadelphia Gospel Movement. In the past month, we worked to help launch their Marketplace ministry, first education project, website (philadelphiagospelmovement.org), and bi-weekly events newsletter (sign-up online).

On November 16th, we will host a leader in the business community of NYC who is passionate about bringing Christians together to advance the gospel and Kingdom of God (info on above site). Bob Doll will share in Newtown Square, Old City (American Bible Society), and Telford what they have done and cast vision for Philly. This is a fundraiser, but please do not feel an obligation to give. You will experience a fuller picture of what have done and will do through your prayers and gifts.
