Not that I was ever in need, for I have learned to get along happily whether I have much or little. I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of contentment in every situation, whether it be a full stomach or hunger, plenty or want; for I can do everything God asks me to do with the help of Christ who gives me the strength and power.

Philippians 4:11-12 L. B.

What a blessing it would be for all of us to be able to say as the Apostle Paul did, "I have learned to be content in all circumstances!" According to the Apostle Paul, he found the secret of contentment in a life submitted to Jesus Christ. He said in Philippians 4:13, that he "could do all things through Christ that strengthens him."

All of us are trying to find contentment and peace in our lives. To quench this driving thirst we can drink from two sources of water, the salt water of materialism or the living water of Jesus Christ (John 4:10). I pray that we all will choose to drink of the water that Jesus Christ offers, which will give us that peace (contentment) that passes all understanding. (Philippians 4:7)







A New Start Through New Day

It is great to be fully vaccinated and back at New Day Drop-In Center in Kensington. I'm (Katie) encouraged to see that so many familiar faces who have survived not only the pandemic, but the interruption of so many social services. Things look a little different now at this drop-in center for women. We prepare their lunches instead of giving them use of the kitchen. In lieu of having the women rummage through available clothing themselves, I hold up piece by piece in their size, often goods donated from you.

The first picture above is funny. After years of neglect, little sunlight was coming through the filthy windows at the space. So a New Day worker and I put on trash bag rain ponchos and cleaned the windows with supplies I brought from our home.

New Day has even been a blessing in a unique situation for a church member. A friend of ours from church welcomed in a neighbor who struggles with addiction, and who needed to leave an unhealthy situation.

The family that took in the young woman treated her like one of the family. She joined them for family meals and they helped take care of her basic needs. Each night they would read the Bible together and pray. The young woman heard the gospel many times over, but she wasn't quite ready to say goodbye to her addiction and left their

home. The family, particularly the wife, remained close with the young woman.

Three months later, the young woman was finally ready to give up her addiction and get some help. After a couple of tries that were unsuccessful at getting into a rehab, I passed along the hotline number for New Day. The young woman called and a case worker talked with her about a plan. They picked up the young woman and drove her to rehab. With the help of the caseworker from New Day, there will be a solid long-term plan to stay clean, receive job training, and help this young woman start a new life!

Please be praying for this young woman, "D". She has a lot of darkness in her life, but the light of Jesus can overcome it. She also has had a lot of trauma that she needs to be healed from. The journey of someone like this young woman is never a quick, straight line. It's often up and down, back and forth. God never gives up on anyone though! Pray for "D" to be continually drawn to the light and receive freedom that only Jesus can bring.

Stephen Ministers held their meeting on Thursday, May 6th and May 20th starting at 1:30pm and ending approximately at 3:30PM


Young Adult Group held their meeting on Tuesday, May 25th starting at 6:30PM and ending approximately at 8:30PM.
