**Event Hours:** Festival grounds are open from 6 a.m. Friday to 12 p.m. on Monday. **Early admittance is not allowed.**

#### **Driving Directions from the Epsom Rotary:**

**Proceed North on Rt. 128 for 11.2 miles and proceed through Center Barnstead. Turn Right onto Bow Lake Rd. after the T.L. Storer sign. At the "T" with Tasker Road turn right and proceed 1.4 miles to the camp.**

**Tent Camping:** Your weekend pass entitles you to: Camp on site for the entire weekend. Parking is free in the weekend parking lot. **No Parking** at your site. There are no cabins available for patron use. All cabins and buildings are being used for festival activities and housing volunteers and staff.

**RV Camping:** RVs are welcome. Parking for RVs is on a first come, first serve basis in the designated areas. There **may** be a limited number of RV sites with power, for an additional fee. Each RV spot can accommodate one vehicle (any additional vehicles will be parked in weekend parking). **Vehicles are not permitted to drive around the campground.**

**For Your Comfort:** You should bring warm clothes, towels, extra shoes, a lawn chair, a blanket, rain gear, bug spray, sunscreen, and a flashlight with extra batteries. Campers should also provide their own tents, sleeping gear, and toiletries. Small items may be available for sale at the local store. **Please check your equipment before you leave.**
