






AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE TIP

Wooden props have been around 100 years, and you'd think everyone would know everything there is to know about them, but you'd be surprised how many owners neglect their wooden props! Wooden props need to be re-torqued seasonally as the wood expands and contracts with heat and moisture. Props are also supposed to be stored horizontally, as moisture in the prop can travel to the lowest point and put a prop out of balance. AC 20-37E talks about propeller maintenance and has lots of good information. So, when the seasons change, give your mechanic a call and have them retorque your wood prop! If not, props like this one that are only 4 years old can crack and become junk! This replacement was \$3400 and took 3 months to get!
