BEEN TAKEN FROM US AND DOLED OUT TO OTHER FORMS AND LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT, WE CAN STILL DO OUR MANDATED WORK THROUGH PARTNERSHIPS AND JOINT OPERATIONS TO ASSURE THE BASIC NECCESITIES OF LIFE AND ALSO QUALITY OF LIFE CONCERNS.

EDUCATION, CHILDCARE, PHYSICAL & MENTAL HEALTH, AND JOBS CONSISTENTLY REMAIN AS THE KEYS TO OPENING THE DOORS TO OPPORTUNITY AND ESCAPE THE PITS OF POVERTY. WE MUST BE AT THE FRONT DOOR OF THIS INITIATIVE OR FACE THE ELIMINATION OF US AS A VIABLE SERVICE TO THOSE WHO NEED OUR SERVICES THE MOST.

WE REJOICE AT THE MENTION OF ANOTHER FACTORY COMING TO TOWN AND INVESTING, BUT WE'VE BEEN ON BOTH SIDES OF THAT AISLE BEFORE. WE MUST REMAIN EVER VIGILANT TO THE RAPIDLY CHANGING CIRCUMSTANCES AND OPPORTUNITIES THAT PRESENT THEMSELVES TO US. WHO WILL BE THE NEXT TO LOSE THEIR JOBS, BE PLACED ON FURLOUGH, OR SUFFER THROUGH A CATASTROPHIC WEATHER INCIDENT? WE DON'T KNOW, BUT WE MUST BE PREPARED BEFORE ONCE AGAIN, THE GIANT HEADLINE-GRABBING ORGANIZATIONS COME TO AND TROUGH TOWN.

TOWNSHIP REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE NUMBERED 2,720 IN 2017, 1,472 IN 2018, AND 1,780 IN 2019. THESE REQUESTS CAME FROM 708 IN 2017, 1,216 IN 2018, AND 1,780 IN 2019. THE COSTS OF THESE SERVICES WAS 222,000 IN 2017, 254,000 IN 2018, AND 426,00 IN 2019. DOLLAR AMOUNTS BOUNCED ALL OVER EQUALLY IN: HOUSING, HEALTHCARE, FUNERALS, EMERGENCY SHELTER, WORKFARE, AND PAYEE MANAGEMENT.

CASE MANAGEMENT VALUE FOR INVESTIGATING, COUNSELING, BUDGETING, REFERRING, PHONE CALLS, FORMS ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE TIME OF STAFF WAS VALUED AT 561,000.00 IN 2017, 632,000.00 IN 2018, AND 565,000.00 IN 2019. THESE VALUES ARE ESTABLISHED BY STANDARDS APPROVED BY THE SBOA.

WITH ALL OF THIS WE STILL SHOWED AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2019 TOTAL FUNDS OF \$4, 124,758.32 OF CASH BALANCES WITH AN ON DEMAND CHECKING

ACCOUNT OF APPROXIMATELY 3.5 MILLION DOLLARS. THIS DESPITE EFFORTS TO RELIEVE US OF DOLLARS AS IF WE HAVE NO IDEA OF HOW TO MANAGE OUR SMALL PIECE OF THE PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS.

THERE ARE SOME INITIATIVES AVAILABLE TO US THAT CAN AND WILL ACCOMPLISH OUR MISSION TASKS AND ALSO LET THE TAXPAYERS KNOW THE WHO AND WHAT OF THE CONTRIBUTION. OPPORTUNITIES THAT WILL ALSO ALLOW US TO PARTNER WITH GROUPS THAT WILL EFFECTUALLY AID OUR CLIENTS TO ESCAPE THE CLUTCHES OF THOSE THINGS WHICH SERVE TO BIND THEM AND HOLD THEM BACK. HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND TRAINING THAT WILL FIT WITHIN OUR FRAMEWORK WITHOUT DRAINWORK, AND I WILL BE PRESENTING THESE TO THIS BOARD TO HELP OUR CITIZENS AND THUS OUR CITY, COUNTY, AND TOWNSHIP.

WE ARE LOOKING TO PARTNER WITH THE ST. VINCENT FOUNDATION THROUGH THE CAMPAIGN FOR THE CANCER CENTER. OUR MISSION DOVETAILS WITH THEIRS IN OUR COMMON CARE FOR THOSE OF ALL WALKS OF LIFE AND ESPECIALY THOSE WHO ARE STRUGGLING, AFFECTED BY POVERTY OR VULNERABLE DUE TO SAME.

THE EDUCATIONAL HAND UP WILL BE EXTENDED THROUGH OUR PARTNERSHIP WITH IVY TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE. WITH 60% OF OUR STATE'S WORKFORCE HAVING A HIGH –VALUE POST SECONDARY DEEGREE WE WANT TO DO OUR PART IN CLOSING THE GAP BETWEEN THOSE WHO ARE QUALIFIED AND THOSE WHO ARE NOT WHILE AT THE SAME TIME DRIVING OUR ECONOMY FORWARD AND UPWARD. WE WILL BE ASSISTING IN PROVIDING A PATHWAY TO STUDENT SUCCESS.

ADDITIONALY WE WILL CONTINUE TO PARTNER WITH THE 17-20 COOPERATING AGENCIES JOINING WITH AND STRUGGLING ALONGSIDE US AS WE SERVE THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWNSHIP, CITY, AND COUNTY. WE SCRUTINIZE SO THAT WE WON'T COMPROMISE, WE REPLICATE SO THAT WE DON'T DUPLICATE, WE ARE TOWNSHIP, and WE ARE TEAM TRUSTEE WITH 20/20 VISION.
