"Our passion is to carry on what was handed down to us. The history, how it evolved—for us it's paying tribute and honoring all the Baldknobbers performers who came before us. Even though we weren't there in 1959 or 1989, we want to make sure people see how special it is, as we help carry it on and hopefully hand it to someone else to carry on further."



very Spring, I get a little homesick. I grew up in Pella, lowa. It's a storybook town, full of Dutch culture and rich tradition. There Furthermore, let's be real, I didn't are bakeries, meat markets, windmills have a job or a place to live. I had and Dutch architecture lining every brick street. Each Spring, the entire town is painted in the beauty of thousands of tulips and prepares itself degree in tow—vowing to hate for a three day festival—*Tulip Time* where the entire community dresses in Dutch attire and wooden shoes. As its official tagline describes. Pella is "a touch of Holland."

I had always been a Pella girl, if I left, what would I be?

I didn't want to leave the town I loved, but I loved my parents more. a diploma and a packed-up dorm room. So, I made the tearful drive to Missouri—my English and journalism everything about my new home before I even arrived.

When my parents suggested that I audition for a show in Branson, I rolled my eyes. Branson was full of


Pella was always my identity. My family is Dutch. My grandparents spoke Dutch. I was a Pella girl through and through. It was home. and I never envisioned living in any other area code. Well, this is where God took over. After I graduated from Central College—located in the heart of Pella—my parents informed me that the company for which they worked—Pella Windows and Doors—was moving them to Missouri. hillbillies. "like the buck teeth guvs on those Balknobbers' billboards." I remember saving those very words. I was an educated college graduate with a degree, and words like sophisticated vocabulary.

God has quite the sense of humor. I ended up auditioning, on a whim. for the Shoji Tabuchi Show, and somehow, with zero experience and complete naivety. I got the job. What a blessing. The minute I started, I knew I was doing what I was meant to do. Music has always been my love. I always wanted to be a singer. But those are dreams, and for an lowa girl, stages for a singing career don't exist. Had I stayed in Pella, being a singer would have remained Continued on page 30



THEIR STORY Music in the Morace family

lusic in the Morace family began, well, pretty much at the beginning. Robert, the husband and Dad of the group, started playing piano in church at the age of 3. Since then, his talent has never stopped growing.

Leisa, Robert's wife (and the Mom in the group), also began her career as a child singing in church, (located in a small Louisiana town just a few miles from young Robert's.)

Like Robert, Leisa's talent and her love for singing never stopped.

The two met when a group Robert was performing in was in need of a female vocalist. Since the girl trying out for that role lived in a small town that was

on Robert's way to his rehearsal, he was charged with picking up the applicant for her audition. The two immediately hit it off. The girl, (Leisa) got the job (of course). Then came love, then came marriage, then came children—and the music never stopped.



Both of the Morace daughters, without any pressure from the parents, wanted to sing with their family from the very "git-go" (as they say in Louisiana). What fast became apparent, was the amazing vocal gifts both girls had. It wasn't long before the family became a family singing group. They began in church, travelled to other churches, then performed at events, festivals, shows, and on TV. In-between, they would hit the recording studios in Nashville to produce their latest album.



Many lemur species have already gone extinct in the last 2000 years due to human activity. Because of these threats and their declining numbers, environmentalist groups consider lemurs to be the world's most endangered mammals, noting that as of 2013 up to 90% of all lemur species confront the threat of extinction in the wild within the next 20 to 25 years. Many efforts try to preserve lemur habitats as well as promote public awareness and appreciation for lemurs.
