ranson Terry Music Awards founder transformation, Terry has been on a and producer Terry Beene has lived a storied life. It was a long and winding road of a life before the **Terry** Awards came to Branson some years ago.

Part of that life was lived serving in the United States Navy aboard the USS **Roosevelt, USS Kennedy and USS** Enterprise. Then, several years of it were spent traveling the world as a drummer for some of the biggest names in the world of country music, which later led to years of being a legendary record producer, disc jockey and TV show host in Fort Worth, Texas. It was at that point when famously, as we learned back on page 10—he began The Terry Awards as a joke.

But in the midst of it all, was the bad news hinted at in the previous part of this story. Drugs caused Terry's life to spiral into addiction.

The breaking point was when a friend driving a tour bus in the middle of the night spotted him wandering along a Texas freeway, an event Terry doesn't even remember. "It was a God thing," Terry tells us.

But it was one that landed him in rehab, where he ended up living for an entire year. "For some Godly reason, God was lookin' after me" says Terry.

Fortunately, he came out of rehab, even though many of his friends did not, their lives being snuffed out due to the devastation of their addictions. Terry's life had been on its way to a similar sad ending, yet in contrast, his life suddenly became an absolute joy ride! The title of his speaking engagements is the big clue—"From Druas to Jesus."

Since that life

different track. Although living in Georgia, his love for country music and for people who need the love of God brought him to Branson to continue The Terry Awards, this time for a completely different reason—to raise money for charity.

Charities is where the ticket money goes to musicians who need medical bills paid, or whose children need financial help for their schooling, or for others needing car repairs or having other pressing needs. As Terry tells The Insider, "We're not doin' it for the money, we're doin' it out of love for people in need."

All year long, Terry is joyfully laboring to produce Branson's annual extravaganza. To cite a quote from Terry himself, The Branson Terry Awards, in the midst of all the glitz, the glamour and fun—is definitely "a God thing." +



# REMEMBERING OUR BRANSON LEGENDS

In these past weeks, we've lost two legendary entertainers—loved by the entire Branson community and by generations of family, friends and fans throughout the world. In a few short words, we wish to pay tribute to their legacy—with all our hearts.

### **BOB LEFTRIDGE**



January 19, 1942— September 21, 2023

ranson nation for years has D enjoyed the incredible music and D comedy skills of Bob as he served as the "front man" for Branson's iconic **Baldknobbers** show. A true country boy from Lentner, Missouri, Bob as a young aspiring entertainer, teamed up with a buddy to form the performing duo of Luther & Goofer, a music and comedy act that fast got them on TV, the Ozark Opry at Lake of the Ozarks, The Ozark Nashville Opry—and onto Nashville, where Bob joined the prominent band The Homesteaders. He soon became a Grand Ol' Opry mainstay, working alongside the biggest stars in country music. That led him to traveling the world, performing at New York's Carnegie Hall, and to lead vocals on the 1966 hit "Show Me the Way to the **Circus**" A prolific songwriter, he began penning hits for both himself and for other Nashville stars. He later became the front man for the legendary Ozarks Country Jubilee in nearby Springfield. Bob has been known as the consummate emcee, cowboy singer, impressionist, guitar picker, bass vocalist, plus as a hilarious comedian. He is survived by his loving wife Kay, two sons and their families and many beloved nieces, nephews, grandchildren and friends.

## **BUCK TRENT**



February 17, 1938– October 9, 2023

ailing from Spartanburg, South Carolina, Buck's talents resulted in being able to perform on radio at the age of 11. Those developing talents included becoming a whiz on banjo, dobro, steel guitar, mandolin, electric bass and guitar. He burst upon the Nashville scene in 1959 when he first appeared on the Grand Ol Opry. From there he went on to play and travel with country music legends **Bill Monroe**, Porter Wagoner, Roy Clark and Dolly Parton, appearing regularly on The Roy Clark TV Show, Hee-Haw and playing on Dolly's immortal classics "I Will Always Love You" and "Jolene." With Roy Clark. he was part of the first country music show to appear in the Soviet Union. With Mickey Gilley, he became one of the first national acts to open a show in Branson. Generations will never forget his signature phrase, (which originated on Hee-Haw)-the thumbs up, "Uh-huh, oh yeah!"

Branson Mayor Larry Milton has proclaimed December 13 as Buck Trent Day. In October Buck was inducted into the Banjo Hall of Fame. He is survived by his loving wife Jean Trent, two children, three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.




