

HOUSE RULES OF AMERICAN LEGION POST 716, LOS ALAMITOS *(THESE RULES SHALL APPLY TO*

ALL THAT MAKE USE OF THIS FACILITY) I. The following shall be admitted into the Post Social Quarters:

(Must be 21 unless escorted by a parent or guardian and no Minor may sit at the bar)

- a. All members of The American Legion showing current American Legion card and spouse or escort.
 - b. All members of The American Legion Auxiliary showing current card and spouse or escort.
 - c. All members of The Sons of The American Legion showing current card and spouse or escort.
 - d. All members of The American Legion Riders showing current card and spouse or escort.
 - e. Out of town guests if accompanied by American Legion member showing current card.
 - t. Members are responsible for their guests and may not leave before guests.
 - g. All guests as well as spouses and escorts, not Legion family members shall be properly signed in.
 - h. Any Active Duty or Retired Military, with proper ID cards.
 - i. Members of other Veterans Organizations with valid/current membership card.
2. **Any member without a current membership card** shall be considered "a member not in good standing" and as such will not be permitted to use the Social Quarters and/or may not be signed until such time their dues are brought current.
 3. Persons are expected to dress comfortably and desirably, wear clean clothes and footwear. No gang related Colors, or Logo's, No Patches or Colors of M.C.'s not affiliated with or approved by the American Legion Department of California.
 4. The steward or employee in charge shall have full authority to enforce house rules while on duty and may eject any member for misconduct or violation of house rules. Unless the violation warrants further action, the member may make use of the Social Quarters the next business day.
 5. No member shall reprimand an officer or an employee of The American Legion. Verbal abuse of any member or guest will not be tolerated and may lead to immediate expulsion and/or disciplinary action. Any suggestions or criticisms of the lounge or Legion operations shall be submitted to the Legion Executive Committee or brought before the Members and Officers at a Post meeting if so desired, for consideration.
 6. The employees or attendants on duty may refuse service to anyone. Any member asked to leave the Social Quarters that does not comply will face future disciplinary actions.
 7. Any member removing, damaging, or destroying any property of The American Legion shall pay for damages. Theft of Legion or personal property may result in permanent barring of Post privilege's and may result in loss of membership.
 8. Cashing of checks, or lending of lounge funds is strictly prohibited. The use of Bar Tabs shall be at the discretion of Post Management, amount limitations shall be strictly enforced and without exception.
 9. Legion Officers that have been drinking shall refrain from involving themselves in disagreements in the bar and shall refer any matter to the bartender on duty.
 10. Since the business of this Post concerns all Legion members, all Legion members in the Post shall attend meetings, therefore the Social Quarters shall be closed to all (**Legionnaires**) during Membership meetings and shall open again at the conclusion of the meeting.
 11. Beverages containing alcohol will be allowed in moderation during Membership meeting, unless at the discretion of the Post Commander or in his absence the Officer in Charge of present meeting, deems the occasion warrants the exclusion of alcoholic beverages from said meeting.
 12. If you receive a phone call while you are at the Post you must answer, bartenders will not lie for any member.
 13. No intoxicated and unruly members will be tolerated in the lounge or Meeting Hall.
 14. There shall be absolutely no drinks of any kind taken from or brought into the premises at any time.
 15. Positively no Beverage containing alcohol drinks are to be served to minors or guests not properly signed in under any circumstances.
 16. Dogs or other pets will not be allowed in the lounge. (Properly trained and Certified Service Dogs will be allowed)
 17. Loud, boisterous, crude or profane language will not be tolerated in this Post home.
 18. The lounge will close not later than the time determined by the Post and or the Alcohol and Beverage Control board of the State of California.
 19. Failure to follow **the house rules** may result in disciplinary actions which can include immediate expulsion **from the Social Quarters** and/or further restrictions of its use.
