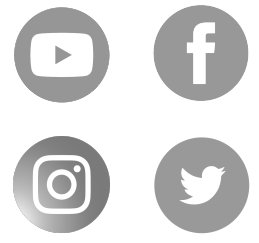

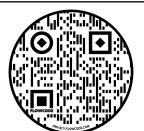

**FINAL CALL RE OUR OCTOBER PILGRIMAGE TO FRANCE:** We are intending to go on pilgrimage as a parish to France from **Monday 21st to Saturday 26th October 2024**. It is half-board with travel, activities, visits and entry fees and tips all included. **PRAYING FOR - AND SUPPORTING - VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD:** The priesthood has always been essential to the life of the Church, from the time of Jesus until today. This Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday when we pray for vocations, for our priests, and take up the Priest Training Fund second collection. This fund pays for the formation of men to become priests in our Archdiocese. After their ordination, our priests dedicate their lives to serving Christ and His people in our parishes, hospitals, schools, chaplaincies, prisons and in service to the needy, throughout South London, Kent and Surrey. We are blessed to have 5 men in formation to the Priesthood for our Archdiocese. However, it costs £30,000 a year to sponsor each seminarian.
