Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. May their souls - and the souls of all the faithful departed - through the mercy of God rest in peace.

It was a joy to welcome into full communion with the Catholic Church the new members of our parish family: Mariam, Evan, Matheo, Ogaga, Sunita, Clara, Abigail, Chase and Joseph at the Easter Vigil. I told them on that night that I was to anoint them with the oil blessed by Archbishop John at the Chrism Mass the previous Wednesday. At the Chrism Mass the Bishop blesses the oils for use in parish ministry and they are three: the oil of the sick, the oil of catechumens (for those to be Baptised) and the oil of Chrism (for those to be confirmed). As it happens I'd already been called to use the oil of the sick in anointing someone close to death on Holy Thursday. I said to our catechumens and candidates that - in using that oil - I consoled and reassured the person being anointed. I reminded the person that they had been chosen and called to a different state of life. Similarly I consoled and reassured our catechumens and candidates in their election by Jesus Christ to a different state of life as well - one lived with an awareness of (and desire for) life beyond this earth. Using the oils of catechumens and Chrism, I promised them that they would receive the Holy Spirit. In this time each one of us - members of the Church - are consoled and reassured that we too will be filled with the Spirit at Pentecost. We have been chosen by our Baptism and called in our vocation - whatever it might be - which is a truth we need at times to hear and remind ourselves of. God has loved us and called us to reflect His love in the world!

PRAYING FOR - AND SUPPORTING - VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD: The priesthood has always been essential to the life of the Church, from the time of Jesus until today. Good Shepherd Sunday (on 21st April) is the day we pray for vocations, for our priests, and take up the Priest Training Fund second collection. This fund pays for the formation of men to become priests in our Archdiocese. After their ordination, our priests dedicate their lives to serving Christ and His people in our parishes, hospitals, schools, chaplaincies, prisons and in service to the needy, throughout South London, Kent and Surrey. We are blessed to have 5 men in formation to the Priesthood for our Archdiocese. However, it costs £30,000 a year to sponsor each seminarian.
